2	authorized by W.S. 18-15-110 shall be remitted by the
3	county treasurer to the district to a separate account and
4	shall be used solely for senior citizen programs <u>or</u>
5	services and for the payment of bond premiums authorized by
6	W.S. 18-15-108(b), but shall not be used for the purchase
7	of real property or for capital construction expenditures.
8	Senior citizen programs may include or services means :
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10	(ii) The expansion of existing senior citizen
11	centers to provide programs <mark>of such as</mark> nutrition, health <u>,</u>
12	in-home services, socialization or transportation; if other
