AN ACT relating to senior citizen service districts; limiting the use of district revenues to senior citizen programs and services as specified; conforming provisions; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

**Section 1.** W.S. 18-15-111(a)(intro), (ii) and by creating a new paragraph (iii) and (b)(intro), (ii) and (iii) is amended to read:

## 18-15-111. Fund; disposition of revenue; contract requirements.

- (a) The revenues collected under the tax levy authorized by W.S. 18-15-110 shall be remitted by the county treasurer to the district to a separate account and shall be used solely for senior citizen programs or services authorized by this subsection and for the payment of bond premiums authorized by W.S. 18-15-108(b), but shall not be used for the purchase of real property or for capital construction expenditures. Senior citizen programs may include or services are limited to the following:
- (ii) The expansion of existing senior citizen centers to provide programs of such as nutrition, health, in-home services, socialization or transportation; if other sources of grant funds are not available. or
- (iii) Participation in programs or services administered through the aging division of the Wyoming department of health, but only programs offered by the department as of January 1, 2017.

- (b) The district may provide directly or contract for the provision of senior citizen programs or services. Contracts for the provision of senior citizen programs or services shall:
- (ii) Specify the manner in which the funds are expended and the programs or services provided; and
- (iii) Require the provider of the programs  $\underline{\text{or}}$   $\underline{\text{services}}$  to present an annual budget for review to determine compliance with this chapter and for approval by the district.

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2017.
