- 2 requiring insurers to determine the full extent of damage
- 3 to a motor vehicle prior to accepting or rejecting an

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7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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9 **Section 1**. W.S. 26-15-124(b) is amended to read:

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- 11 26-15-124. Claim to be accepted or rejected;
- 12 attorney's fee.

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- 14 (b) Claims for benefits under a property or casualty
- 15 insurance policy shall be rejected or accepted and paid by

- 1 the insurer or its agent designated to receive those claims
- 2 within forty-five (45) days after receipt of the claim and
- 3 supporting bills. For a benefits claim under a property or
- 4 casualty insurance policy for damage to a motor vehicle,
- 5 the insurer or its agent designated to receive that claim
- 6 shall not reject or accept and pay the claim until the full
- 7 <u>extent of damage to the motor vehicle is determined.</u>

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- 9 Section 2. This act shall only apply to benefit
- 10 claims under a property or casualty insurance policy for
- 11 damages that occur on or after the effective date of this
- 12 act.

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14 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2021.
