Game and fish-lifetime license elimination.

A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to game and fish; eliminating lifetime
- 2 fishing, small game and game bird licenses; eliminating
- 3 lifetime conservation stamps; providing for grandfathering
- 4 of ownership of those licenses; making conforming
- 5 amendments; and providing for an effective date.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8

- 9 **Section 1.** W.S. 23-1-705(d), 23-2-101(a) and
- 10 23-2-201(a) and (f) are amended to read:

11

- 23-1-705. Complimentary licenses; one-shot antelope
- 13 hunt licenses; gunpowder and buckskin hunt licenses;
- 14 gratuitous licenses; donated licenses.

15

- 16 (d) The department shall issue without charge
- 17 lifetime bird, small game and fish licenses to any resident

1 or honorably discharged veteran who is over sixty-five (65)

2 years and who has continuously resided in Wyoming for at

3 least the thirty (30) years immediately preceding

4 application for the license, or to any disabled veteran who

5 is one hundred percent (100%) disabled as determined by the

6 United States department of veteran affairs. The license is

7 valid so long as the licensee remains a Wyoming resident.

9 23-2-101. Fees; restrictions; nonresident application

10 fee; nonresident licenses; verification of residency

11 required.

13 Any qualified person may purchase a 14 license from the department or its authorized selling agents except as otherwise provided. Purchase of a license 15 entitles the licensee to take any animal, bird or fish 16 17 provided on the license within Wyoming at the time, in a place, in a manner and in an amount as provided by law and 18 the orders of the commission. At the time of application 19 20 for a resident license under this section, the applicant 21 shall provide a valid Wyoming driver's license or a copy 22 thereof, or other proof of residency. The commission shall promulgate reasonable rules and regulations stating what 23 24 proof of residency is required so that only bona fide

- 1 Wyoming residents, as defined in W.S. 23-1-102(a)(ix),
- 2 receive resident licenses. For purposes of purchasing a
- 3 lifetime resident license under subsection (j) of this
- 4 section, an applicant shall have been a resident as defined
- 5 in W.S. 23-1-102(a)(ix) continuously for a ten (10) year
- 6 period immediately preceding the application date.

7

- 8 23-2-201. Fees; restrictions; verification of
- 9 residency required.

- 11 (a) Any qualified person may purchase a fishing 12 license from the department or its authorized selling
- 13 agents. Purchase of a license entitles the licensee to take
- 14 any fish of Wyoming at the time, in a place, in a manner
- 15 and in an amount as provided by law and the orders of the
- 16 commission. At the time of application for a resident
- 17 license under this section, the applicant shall provide a
- 18 valid Wyoming driver's license or a copy thereof, or other
- 19 proof of residency. The commission shall promulgate
- 20 reasonable rules and regulations stating what proof of
- 21 residency is required so that only bona fide Wyoming
- 22 residents, as defined in W.S. 23-1-102(a)(ix), receive
- 23 resident licenses. For purposes of purchasing a lifetime
- 24 resident license under subsection (d) of this section and

1 except for the resident disabled veteran's lifetime license

2 issued under subsection (f) of this section, an applicant

3 shall have been a resident as defined in W.S.

4 23 1 102(a)(ix) continuously for a ten (10) year period

5 immediately preceding the application date.

6

Any resident disabled veteran who receives fifty 7 more service connected disability 8 percent (50%) or 9 compensation from the United States department of veteran's 10 affairs may apply to the department for a resident disabled veteran's lifetime fishing license. The license entitles 11 the resident disabled veteran to take any fish within 12 13 Wyoming at the time, in a place, in a manner and in an amount as provided by law and the orders of the commission. 14 Application shall include proof of residency required under 15 subsection (a) of this section, certification of the 16 17 applicant's service connected disability and other information required by rule and regulation of 18 commission. Notwithstanding subsection (a) and paragraph 19 (d)(viii) of this section, a disabled veteran's lifetime 20 21 fishing license shall be issued to an eligible applicant 22 without payment of any fee.

2 23-2-201(d)(viii) and 23-2-306(b) are repealed.

4 Section 3. Nothing in this act shall affect the

- 5 continued validity of any lifetime fishing license,
- 6 lifetime game bird and small game licenses, lifetime game
- 7 bird/small game and fishing license or any lifetime
- 8 conservation stamp issued under previous law.

10 Section 4. This act is effective January 1, 2015.
