Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 23-1-101(a)(v) is amended to read:

23-1-101. Definitions of wildlife.

(a) As used in this act:

(v) "Game fish" means bass, catfish, crappie, grayling, <u>ling burbot</u>, northern pike, perch, salmon, sauger, sunfish, trout, walleye or whitefish <u>unless the</u> <u>species is otherwise designated by the commission in</u> specific waters through rule and regulation; ORIGINAL HOUSE BILL NO. 0131
