- 14 this section, no city, town, county, special district or
- 15 other political subdivision shall adopt any ordinance,

- 2 raising or keeping six (6) or fewer live chickens within
- 3 the boundaries of the political subdivision.

- 5 (b) A city, town, county, special district or other
- 6 political subdivision may impose any of the following
- 7 restrictions on the raising or keeping of live chickens:

- 9 (i) A restriction on the number of live chickens
- 10 that a person may raise or keep in excess of six (6) live
- 11 chickens;

- 13 (ii) A prohibition on raising or keeping poultry
- 14 other than live chickens;

- 16 (iii) A prohibition on raising or keeping
- 17 roosters;

- 19 (iv) A minimum distance which must be maintained
- 20 between a chicken coop and a residential structure;
