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15 **35-25-104**. Private insurance program benefits.

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A child eligible for services under this act shall receive 1 benefits developed by the health benefits committee 2 3 established under W.S. 35-25-105 that include cost sharing 4 factors, not to exceed the maximum allowable under Public 105-33, exclusions and limitations. 5 Law The benefit package, shall include, at a minimum, inpatient and 6 outpatient hospital services, physician services, 7 8 laboratory and x-ray services, well-baby and well-child 9 care including age appropriate immunizations and the 10 additional services of prescription drug coverage, vision 11 coverage and dental coverage which will include preventive 12 and basic services developed by the health benefits 13 committee conforming to the requirements of minimum essential coverage under 26 U.S.C. § 5000A. 14 15 16 35-25-107. Program expenditures; monitoring; 17 recommendations; required action to limit expenditures to budget available. 18 19 20 The department shall project monthly expenditures 21 under this act each month through the end of the biennium based upon the level of activity for the previous months 22 23 and the trend in expenditures compared to previous

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Τ	expenditures. If the projections indicate that expenditures
2	may exceed the federal and state funds available under this
3	act, the department, may, by rule and regulation and
4	subject to availability of funds, limit participation in
5	the program under this section as follows: The department
6	may consider cost containment actions having no adverse
7	effect on eligibility standards, methods and procedures.
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9	(c) The funding for the child health insurance
10	program shall be deemed to be included within the community
11	and family health division of health care financing line
12	item within the department of health budget unless a
13	separate line item is provided in the budget bill. General
14	fund expenditures for the child health program shall not
15	exceed the amount needed to match federal funds without
16	explicit authorization enacted in the budget bill.
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18	Section 2. W.S. 35-25-107(a)(i) and (ii) and
19	35-25-111 are repealed.
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21	Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2016.
