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5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 7 **Section 1.** W.S. 27-3-402(a) and (e),
- 8 27-3-404(a)(intro) and 27-3-506(d) are amended to read:

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- 10 27-3-402. Determination; generally; referral to
- 11 special examiner; redetermination; notice; appeal.

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- 13 (a) Determination of a claim filed pursuant to W.S.
- 14 27-3-401(a) shall be made promptly by a deputy designated
- 15 by the department. If a claim is denied, the determination

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- 1 shall state the reasons for denial. Except as provided by
- 2 subsection (c) of this section, a determination is final
- 3 unless a party entitled to notice applies for
- 4 redetermination or appeals the determination within fifteen
- 5 (15) twenty-eight (28) days after notice is mailed to his
- 6 last known address of record.

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- 8 (e) The claimant or any other party entitled to
- 9 notice of a determination may appeal the determination to
- 10 an appeal tribunal. The appeal shall be filed with the
- 11 tribunal within fifteen (15) twenty-eight (28) days after
- 12 notice is mailed to the last known address of record of the
- 13 interested party.

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- 27-3-404. Determination; review by commission;
- 16 disposition; notice; reconsideration.

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- 18 (a) The commission may within fifteen (15) twenty-
- 19 eight (28) days after notice is mailed or delivered:

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21 27-3-506. Notice of rates and charges; relief, review

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22 or redetermination.

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(d) An employer may apply to the department for 1 2 review of a decision or determination 3 contribution liability, contribution rates or the charging 4 of benefit payments under W.S. 27-3-509. The application 5 shall be in writing and shall state the reasons for review. The department, on behalf of the commission, shall notify 6 the employer of its acceptance or denial of the application 7 8 for review or of a redetermination by the commission. If 9 the commission grants review, the employer shall be given 10 opportunity for hearing in accordance with W.S. 27-3-401 11 through 27-3-409 to the extent not inconsistent with this 12 article. An employer in any proceeding involving contribution rates or liability may not contest benefits 13 paid and charged to his account in accordance with a 14 determination, redetermination or decision pursuant to W.S. 15 16 27-3-401 through 27-3-409 unless he was not a party to the proceeding. A denial or redetermination is final unless 17 within thirty (30) days after notice is mailed a petition 18 19 for judicial review is filed in accordance with W.S. 20 27-3-407.
