2	(iii) "Volunteer" means <u>:</u>

4	(A) An officer, director, trustee or other
5	person who performs services for a nonprofit organization
6	but does not receive compensation, either directly or
7	indirectly, for those services; or

9	(B) A volunteer firefighter who performs
10	services for a volunteer fire department under W.S.
11	35-9-601(h) 35-9-616(a)(ix) whether or not he the
12	firefighter receives compensation or a pension:

14	(C) An individual engaged in search and
15	rescue operations under a county sheriff's coordination
16	pursuant to W.S. 18-3-609(a)(iii) or supervision pursuant
17	to W.S. 19-16-101 whether or not the individual receives
18	compensation.

20	(b) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this
21	section, a volunteer who provides services or performs
22	duties on behalf of a nonprofit organization, or a
23	volunteer fire department or a sheriff as part of a search

and rescue operation is personally immune from civil 1 2 liability for any act or omission resulting in damage or 3 injury if at the time of the act or omission: 4 5 (i) The person was acting within the scope of his duties as a volunteer for the nonprofit organization, 6 or volunteer fire department or a sheriff as part of a 7 8 search and rescue operation; and 9 10 (d) In any suit against a nonprofit organization, or 11 a volunteer fire department or a sheriff as part of a 12 search and rescue operation for civil damages based upon the negligent act or omission of a volunteer, proof of the 13 act or omission shall be sufficient to establish the 14 15 responsibility of the organization or department under the 16 doctrine of respondeat superior, notwithstanding the immunity granted to the volunteer with respect to any act 17 or omission included under subsection (b) of this section. 18 19 20 1-42-201. Definitions. 21 (a) As used in this act: 22

1 (vi) "Public employee" means any officer, 2 employee or servant of a local government including elected 3 or appointed officials and persons acting on behalf or in 4 service of the local government in any official capacity, whether with or without compensation., including 5 individuals engaged in search and rescue operations under 6 the coordination of a county sheriff pursuant to W.S. 7 18-3-609(a)(iii). "Public employee": 8 9 10 **Section 2.** W.S. 1-39-103(a)(iv)(D) is repealed. 11 Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon 12 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 13 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 14 15 Constitution. 16 17 (END)
