- 2 reporting requirements for persons involved in vehicle

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 8 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-5-1106(c), 31-5-1108(a) and
- 9 31-5-1111 are amended to read:

- 31-5-1106. Written reports required of driver and
- 12 police officer; reporting of vehicles struck by bullets.

- 14 (c) Every police officer who investigates a motor
- 15 vehicle accident of which report must be made as required
- 16 in this section resulting in bodily injury to or death of

1 any person or total property damage to an apparent extent

of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or more, either at the

3 time of and at the scene of the accident or thereafter by

4 interviewing the participants or witnesses shall forward a

5 written report of the accident to the highway department

6 within ten (10) days after his investigation of the

7 accident.

9 31-5-1108. Report forms; failure to make report;

10 false report.

The highway department shall prepare and upon 12 13 request supply to police departments, coroners, sheriffs and other suitable agencies or individuals, forms for 14 accident reports required hereunder, appropriate with 15 respect to the persons required to make the reports and the 16 17 purposes to be served. The written reports to be made by persons involved in accidents and by investigating officers 18 shall call for sufficiently detailed information to 19 20 disclose with reference to a traffic accident the cause, 21 conditions then existing and the persons and vehicles

involved.

24 31-5-1111. Reports required by municipalities.

2 (a) Any municipality may by ordinance require that 3 the driver of a vehicle involved in an accident, or the 4 owner of the vehicle, shall also file with a designated 5 city department a report of the accident or a copy of any report herein required to be filed with the 6 department. All reports shall be for the confidential use 7 of the city department and subject to W.S. 31-5-1110. Any 8 9 accident report required of persons involved in accidents shall be without prejudice to the individual so reporting 10 11 and shall be for the confidential use of the municipality for accident prevention purposes, except that: 12 13 14 (i) The municipality may disclose the identity of a person involved in an accident when the identity is 15 not otherwise known or when the person denies his presence 16 17 at the accident; 18 19

(ii) The municipality shall disclose to any person requesting such information whether any person or vehicle was covered by a vehicle insurance policy and the name of the insurer.
