Hathaway expand Wyoming scholarships.

## A BILL

for

- AN ACT relating to education; providing for scholarships to out-of-state students to attend Wyoming institutions of higher education; specifying scholarship amounts,
- 4 eligibility requirements and other elements of the
- 5 scholarships; providing for resident tuition for
- 6 scholarship recipients; creating a selection committee;
- 7 creating an account; providing applicability; and providing
- 8 for an effective date.

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10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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12 **Section 1**. W.S. 21-16-1312 is created to read:

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- 21-16-1312. Hathaway expand Wyoming scholarship;
- 15 eligibility requirements and conditions; selection.

2 There is created the Hathaway expand Wyoming (a) 3 scholarship. The scholarship shall be administered by the 4 department in accordance with this section and rules 5 adopted by the department. Scholarship recipients shall be selected by a committee comprised of the governor, state 6 superintendent of public instruction, president of the 7 8 University of Wyoming and executive director of the 9 community college commission, or their designees.

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11 (b) Each year two (2) students from each state 12 contiquous to Wyoming may be awarded a Hathaway expand 13 Wyoming scholarship. Minimum initial qualifications for a Hathaway expand Wyoming scholarship shall be all initial 14 15 requirements applicable to a Hathaway honor scholarship, 16 other than Wyoming residency and graduation from a high 17 located in Wyoming. In addition to school those 18 requirements, recipients shall have:

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20 (i) A minimum cumulative high school GPA of 3.75
21 and a score equal to or greater than the 2015-2016 national
22 percentile rank of ninety-six (96) on an examination
23 administered throughout the United States and relied upon

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1 by institutions of higher education to determine acceptance

2 of students for attendance;

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(ii) At the time of graduation, be a resident of a state contiguous to Wyoming and have successfully completed a curriculum at least as stringent as that imposed under W.S. 21-16-1307 for Hathaway honor

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scholarships.

10 (c) A Hathaway expand Wyoming scholarship shall be 11 for the cost of attendance of the student for attendance at 12 an eligible institution, but not to exceed the maximum 13 dollar amount provided to students receiving a trustee scholarship at the University of Wyoming and subject to 14 reduction in accordance with W.S. 21-16-1309(a). No student 15 16 shall be eligible for a scholarship under this section for more than the equivalent of eight (8) full-time semesters. 17 18 Minimum continuing eligibility and reinstatement 19 eligibility requirements for a Hathaway expand Wyoming 20 scholarship shall be the same as requirements for a 21 Hathaway honors scholarship. These minimum requirements 22 may be increased by rule of the department to requirements no more stringent than those imposed by the University of 23

1 Wyoming for recipients of a trustee scholarship. Hathaway 2 expand Wyoming scholarships may be reduced in the same 3 manner and to lower levels as provided for Hathaway honor

4 scholarships for failure to meet continuing eligibility

5 requirements.

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7 (d) Scholarships under this section shall not be

9 administered by the department in accordance with the

10 provisions of this section and the following:

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(i) The department shall, in consultation with
University of Wyoming and community college admissions
officers and financial aid officers, promulgate rules
necessary to implement this section. The consultation shall
include development of a means for informing students in
contiguous states of the availability of scholarships under

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this section;

20 (ii) Eligible institutions shall provide 21 information required by the department as necessary to 22 fulfill its duties under this section;

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1 (iii) Students shall apply for scholarships 2 under this section with the department at the time of 3 applying for admission or at an earlier time as established 4 by rule of the department. The application shall contain information required by rule of the department. 5 application shall require each applicant to verify under 6 penalty of false swearing under W.S. 6-5-303, that the 7 8 applicant has not been convicted of a felony in this state 9 or another jurisdiction; 10 11 (iv) The department shall determine and certify 12 to the state treasurer the amount of scholarships awarded under this section for attendance at each eligible 13 institution not later than September 1 for the fall 14 15 semester and not later than January 15 for the spring 16 semester. Upon receipt of the certification the state 17 treasurer shall pay from the scholarship expenditure 18 account the amount certified by the department; 19 20 (v) The same information required to be reported 21 under W.S. 21-16-1308 for Hathaway opportunity, performance 22 and honor scholarships shall be reported for scholarships 23 awarded under this section.

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1 2 (e) Before awarding a scholarship under this section, 3 the department shall obtain an agreement from each student, 4 or the student's quardian, under which the student agrees 5 to: 6 7 (i) Actively engage in work in Wyoming for one 8 (1) year or attend graduate school at the University of Wyoming for one (1) year, for every four (4) academic 9 10 semesters or portions thereof in which a scholarship under 11 this section was provided. The department shall establish 12 by rule the commencement of the period for undertaking the requirements of this paragraph, which period shall begin 13 not later than one (1) year after the completion of the 14 last semester in which a scholarship was received under 15 16 this section; or 17 18 (ii) Repay all scholarship amounts provided 19 pursuant to this section, together with interest which 20 shall begin accruing four (4) years after execution of the

immediately upon the department determining that the

- 3 Money expended under this section shall accrue at an annual
- 4 interest rate equal to that charged for federal Stafford
- 5 loans at the time interest begins to accrue, which rate
- 6 shall be adjusted annually to match the federal Stafford
- 7 loan rate. In no event shall the interest rate be greater
- 8 than eight percent (8%). Any amounts repaid by scholarship
- 9 recipients shall be deposited to the Hathaway student
- 10 scholarship endowment fund created by W.S. 9-4-204(u)(vii).

- 12 **Section 2.** W.S. 21-16-1302(a), 21-16-1309(b)(i) and
- 13 (ii), 21-17-105 by creating a new subsection (h) and
- 14 21-18-202(a)(iii) are amended to read:

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- 16 21-16-1302. Hathaway scholarship expenditure account
- 17 created; reserve account created; use and appropriation of
- 18 funds.

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- 20 (a) The Hathaway scholarship expenditure account is
- 21 created to consist of earnings from the Hathaway student
- 22 scholarship endowment fund created by W.S. 9-4-204(u)(vii)
- 23 and such other funds appropriated by the legislature to the

expenditure account. Eighty percent (80%) of all monies 1 2 deposited to the expenditure account under this section shall be available for scholarships under W.S. 21-16-1304, 3 4 and 21-16-1305 and 21-16-1312. Twenty percent (20%) of all monies deposited to the expenditure account under this 5 section shall be available for scholarships under W.S. 6 21-16-1306. Monies within the expenditure account are 7 8 continuously appropriated to the state treasurer for 9 distribution to eligible institutions based on scholarships 10 awarded under this article. All unexpended and 11 unencumbered monies within the expenditure account at the 12 end of each fiscal year shall be deposited by the state 13 treasurer to the Hathaway student scholarship reserve 14 account. 15 16 21-16-1309. Scholarship amounts. 17 (b) To the extent sufficient funds are not available 18 19 in the expenditure account to fund all scholarships as 20 provided under this article: 21 (i) Funds available for scholarships under W.S. 22

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        21-17-105. Tuition to be as nearly free as possible;

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        (h) Trustees shall through regulation provide that
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    students receiving a Hathaway expand Wyoming scholarship in
    any amount shall qualify for resident tuition at the
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    university each semester the student receives the

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        21-18-202. Powers and duties of the commission.
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1 The commission shall perform the following (a) 2 general functions: 3 4 (iii) Establish residency requirements, which 5 shall include provisions for military veterans, their spouses and children consistent with the requirements of 6 21-17-105(e). The commission shall provide that 7 8 students receiving a Hathaway expand Wyoming scholarship in 9 any amount shall qualify for resident tuition each semester 10 the student receives the scholarship; 11 Section 3. There is created the Hathaway expand 12 13 Wyoming scholarship account within the Hathaway student scholarship endowment fund. For accounting and investing 14 15 purposes only the scholarship account shall be treated as a 16 separate account. The state treasurer is authorized to 17 accept private monetary gifts for the account. The Hathaway 18 expand Wyoming scholarship account shall exist until the 19 state treasurer certifies to the department of education 20 the balance of the Hathaway expand Wyoming scholarship 21 account is equal to or greater than five million dollars

(\$5,000,000.00). Once the balance of the Hathaway expand

Wyoming scholarship account is equal to or greater than

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1	five million dollars (\$5,000,000.00), the funds within the
2	account shall be treated as funds of the Hathaway student
3	scholarship endowment fund and the Hathaway expand Wyoming
4	scholarship account shall cease to exist.
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6	Section 4. Notwithstanding W.S. 21-16-1312 as created
7	by this act, no Hathaway expand Wyoming scholarships shall
8	be awarded until the state treasurer certifies to the
9	department of education the balance of the Hathaway expand
10	Wyoming scholarship account is equal to or greater than
11	five million dollars (\$5,000,000.00). Once that threshold
12	has been reached and the account has ceased to exist
13	pursuant to section 3 of this act, Hathaway expand Wyoming
14	scholarships shall be awarded pursuant to W.S. 21-16-1312.
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16	Section 5. This act is effective July 1, 2018.
