Electronic citation fees.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to criminal court case fees; providing for  
2 collection of electronic citation fees in municipal courts  
3 as specified; providing for establishment and maintenance  
4 of municipal electronic citation systems; and providing for  
5 an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 5-6-108 by creating a new subsection  
10 (b) is amended to read:

12 **5-6-108. Costs.**

14 (b) For all misdemeanor criminal or traffic  
15 citations, each clerk shall charge and collect an  
16 electronic citation fee of five dollars (\$5.00). The fee

1 shall be paid by the defendant upon a conviction or plea of  
2 guilty or nolo contendere. The fee shall be in addition to  
3 all other fees and charges and assessable as costs. Fifty  
4 percent (50%) of the fee shall be deposited in the  
5 municipal court's electronic citation fund, created  
6 pursuant to this subsection, and fifty percent (50%) shall  
7 be disbursed to the issuing agency. The funds collected in  
8 the electronic citation fund and disbursed to the arresting  
9 agency shall only be used to defray costs and expenses  
10 related to establishing and maintaining electronic citation  
11 systems. In developing the electronic citation system, the  
12 local municipality shall follow the uniform citation form  
13 established by the Wyoming supreme court.

14

15 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2014.
