punishable by a fine of not more than seven hundred fifty 1 2 dollars (\$750.00), or imprisoned in the county jail 3 imprisonment for not more than one hundred (100) days, or both., in the discretion of the court. 4 5 6 (b) Nothing in this act chapter applies to or prevents a child under fourteen (14) years of age to be 7 8 employed in a nonhazardous occupation outside of school hours by his parents, grandparents or legal guardian, or by 9 a business owned by his parents, grandparents or legal 10 11 quardian. 12 13 Section 2.
