A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to education; requiring required remedial
2 classes at the university and community colleges to be free
3 of tuition and fees; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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7 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-17-105 by creating a new
8 subsection (e), 21-18-205(a)(i) and by creating a new
9 paragraph (iii) and 21-18-307 are amended to read:

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11 **21-17-105. Tuition to be as nearly free as possible;**
12 **number, qualifications and selection of students for**
13 **reduced tuition; reciprocal residency.**

15 (e) Any student graduating from a high school in this
16 state who is required by the university to undertake a

1 remedial class not credited toward a degree shall receive
2 such study free of tuition and fees.

4 **21-18-205. Appropriation and distribution of state**
5 **funds; restrictions; budget authority.**

7 (a) To qualify for state funding, a community college
8 shall:

9

10 (i) Be accredited academically by the regional
11 accrediting agency; ~~and~~

13 (iii) Be in compliance with W.S. 21-18-307.

15 **21-18-307. Admission of state high school graduates**
16 **without examination.**

17

18 (a) A person who graduates from a high school in this
19 state shall be admitted to a community college of this
20 state without further qualifying examination.

21

22 (b) Any student graduating from a high school in this
23 state who is required by a community college to undertake a

1 remedial class not credited toward a degree or certificate
2 shall receive such study free of tuition and fees.

3

4 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2013.
