11 **22-1-102.** Definitions.

- 13 (a) The definitions contained in this chapter apply
- 14 to words and phrases used in this Election Code and govern
- 15 the construction of those words and phrases unless they are

specifically modified by the context in which they appear. 1 2 As used in this Election Code: 3 4 (xxvi) "Qualified elector" includes every citizen of the United States who is a bona fide resident of 5 Wyoming, has registered to vote and will be at least 6 eighteen (18) years of age on the day of the election at 7 8 which he may offer to vote. No person is a qualified 9 elector who does not show a current, valid photo 10 identification before voting, who is a currently 11 adjudicated mentally incompetent person, or who has been 12 convicted of a felony and his civil or voting rights have 13 not been restored. A literacy test shall not be imposed as 14 a condition to voting in any election; 15 16 (xxxix) "Acceptable identification" means current, valid photo identification and may also include 17 18 one (1) of the identification documents or other proof of 19 identity as specified by rule of the secretary of state as 20 adequate proof of the identity of a voter; 21 22 22-2-119. Qualified elector may vote.

Except as specifically provided otherwise a person may vote 1 2 only if he—the person is a qualified elector, only if the 3 person shows a current, valid photo identification before 4 voting and only in the precinct in which he—the person 5 resides. 6 7 22-3-102.
