Judicial retirement age.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to judicial retirement; modifying mandatory
2 retirement age for supreme court and district court judges;
3 imposing a mandatory retirement age upon circuit court
4 judges; making the act contingent upon passage of a
5 constitutional amendment as specified; and providing for an
6 effective date.

8 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9

10 **Section 1.** W.S. 5-1-106(a) (intro) and (d) and 5-9-111
11 by creating a new subsection (b) are amended to read:

12

13 **5-1-106. Retirement of judges of the supreme court or**
14 **district courts; pension; assignment of retired judges.**

1 (a) A judge of the supreme court or district courts
2 shall retire when he attains the age of ~~seventy (70)~~
3 seventy-five (75) years. A judge is eligible for retirement
4 when he has served as a judge of the supreme court, a
5 district court or both for:

6
7 (d) The retirement benefit provisions of this section
8 shall apply to judges who were appointed prior to July 1,
9 1998 and to judges who have retired and are receiving
10 benefits under this section. Judicial retirement benefits
11 for justices and judges appointed to the bench on or after
12 July 1, 1998 are provided pursuant to W.S. 9-3-701 through
13 9-3-713.

15 **5-9-111. Qualifications.**

16
17 (b) A judge of a circuit court shall retire when he
18 attains the age of seventy-five (75) years.

19
20 **Section 2.** This act is effective only if the electors
21 adopt a constitutional amendment at the 2014 general
22 election modifying the mandatory retirement age for
23 justices and judges, as provided in 2013 House Joint
24 Resolution 1.

2 **Section 3.** Subject to section 2 of this act, this act
3 is effective upon certification of the election results of
4 the 2014 election.
