1	(q) The commission shall, by rule and regulation,
2	establish a process for issuing a resident lifetime fishing
3	license and conservation stamp at no cost to any resident who
4	is permanently and totally disabled. As used in this
5	subsection, "permanently and totally disabled" means the
6	presence of a permanent physical or mental condition that
7	prevents a person from engaging in substantial gainful
8	activity.

13	(a) Not later than July 31, 2007, and not later than
14	July 31 of each subsequent year thereafter, the chief fiscal
15	officer of the game and fish department shall prepare and

4 (a) Subject to subsections (b) and (c) of this section 5 and the applicable fee under W.S. 23-1-701, each sportsman licensed under W.S. 23-2-101, 23-2-107 or 23-2-201 shall 6 purchase a single conservation stamp for twelve dollars 7 8 (\$12.00) which shall be valid for the time period specified in commission rules not to exceed twelve (12) months. 9 The 10 stamp or an authorization signifying purchase of the stamp 11 shall be in the possession of any person exercising rights 12 under any fishing or hunting license issued pursuant to W.S. 13 23-2-101, 23-2-107 or 23-2-201. Holders of special limited fishing permits issued under W.S. 23-2-207 and holders of 14 licenses only under W.S. 23-1-302(q), 23-2-101(j)(v) and 15 16 (vi), 23-2-201(d)(vi), (vii) and (ix), 23-2-201(f) and 17 23-2-201(g) are exempt from the provisions of this section when exercising hunting or fishing privileges provided under 18 19 those specific licenses. Revenues collected from the sale of 20 each stamp under this subsection shall be deposited as 21 follows:
