Executive branch funding restoration.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the operation of state government;
2 providing an appropriation to restore funding for the
3 operation of state government as specified; specifying
4 reporting requirements; and providing for an effective
5 date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.**

10

11 (a) There is appropriated thirty million dollars
12 (\$30,000,000.00) from the legislative stabilization reserve
13 account to the state auditor for purposes of this act.
14 This appropriation shall be for the period beginning with
15 the effective date of this act and ending June 30, 2022.

1 This appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for
2 any other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds
3 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided
4 by law on June 30, 2022.

5

6 (b) The governor may direct the state auditor to
7 transfer funds appropriated under subsection (a) of this
8 section to the department of health, the department of
9 family services or the department of corrections. The
10 transferred funds may be expended to restore reductions
11 contained in the governor's fiscal year 2021-2022 biennial
12 supplemental budget request for social services programs
13 delivered to Wyoming residents.

14

15 (c) The notification and reporting procedures
16 contained in W.S. 9-2-1005(b)(ii) and 9-2-1013(b) shall
17 apply to any transfer directed by the governor under this
18 act irrespective of the amount of the transfer.

1 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
4 Constitution.
