6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 23-3-310 is created to read:

9

10 23-3-310. Possession of road killed wildlife.

11

- 12 (a) The commission shall, in consultation with the
- 13 state transportation commission, adopt rules to establish a
- 14 program whereby any person desiring to possess wildlife

1 killed as a result of motor vehicle collisions on any

2 public road or highway in the state of Wyoming is permitted

3 to do so, provided that he possesses one (1) of the

4 following:

5

6 (i) A letter of prior authorization from the

7 department. Letters of prior authorization may be available

8 through the director to any person or entity which commits

9 to putting road killed wildlife carcasses to a beneficial

10 use;

11

12 (ii) A valid scientific or educational

13 collecting permit for the specific species issued pursuant

14 to W.S. 23-1-302(a)(xiii); or

15

16 (iii) A donation certificate or Wyoming

17 interstate game tag issued by the department, including a

18 certificate or tag issued through electronic licensing. A

19 person desiring to possess a road killed animal shall

20 contact the department before taking possession of an

21 animal to obtain a donation certificate. The rules may

22 provide that a person requesting the donation certificate

23 may have to present the animal for inspection to verify its

- 1 possession meets the criteria of the regulation. The rules
- 2 may also provide for obtaining a donation certificate after
- 3 the person takes possession of the animal.

4

- 5 (b) None of the provisions of this section shall
- 6 apply to bighorn sheep, gray wolves within any area of the
- 7 state where gray wolves are classified as trophy game
- 8 animals, grizzly bears, mountain goats, wildlife species
- 9 covered under the federal Migratory Bird Treaty Act,
- 10 federal threatened or endangered species or those species
- 11 whose possession is prohibited by federal or state statute
- 12 or regulation.

- 14 (c) Nothing in this section shall authorize the
- 15 possession of any illegally taken wildlife or wildlife
- 16 found dead due to causes other than motor vehicle
- 17 collisions.

18

- 19 (d) The commission may through rule require any
- 20 antlers or horns, with skull plate intact, taken pursuant
- 21 to this section to be properly tagged with a Wyoming

22 interstate game tag.

1 **Section 2.** W.S. 23-3-106(a)(i), (ii) and by creating 2 a new paragraph (iii) is amended to read: 3 4 23-3-106. Wyoming game and Wyoming interstate game tags; when required. 5 6 7 (a) Except as provided in subsection (f) of this 8 section and W.S. 23-2-302(e), no person shall ship, 9 transport, or receive for shipment or transportation within 10 Wyoming, any game animal, game bird, or any part thereof, 11 unless tagged with a Wyoming game tag or Wyoming interstate 12 game tag, or unless: 13 14 (i) The transportation is by a person 15 accompanying the carcass of a big or trophy game animal who 16 is in possession of a proper coupon; -or 17 18 (ii) The transportation is by a properly 19 licensed bird or small game hunter in possession of not 20 more than his daily bag or possession limit; - or 21 22 (iii) The transportation is by a person 23 possessing authorization pursuant to W.S. 23-3-310 except

1	an interstate game tag may by rule be required as provided
2	in W.S. 23-3-310(d).
