- 11 (c) The board of trustees shall, subject to the
- 12 case-by-case modification permitted by subsection (d) of
- 13 this section, require the district superintendent to expel
- 14 from school for a period of one (1) year any student
- 15 determined to violate paragraph (a)(v) of this section. The

board of trustees may require the district superintendent
to expel any student determined to violate paragraph (a)(v)
of this section for more than one (1) year if the district
provides educational services to the expelled student in an
alternative setting after the initial one (1) year period
of expulsion.

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2023.
