1 AN ACT relating to the Hathaway student scholarship
2 program; modifying requirements for the Hathaway success
3 curriculum as specified; specifying application; and
4 providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-16-1307(b) by creating a new
9 paragraph (vi), (d)(v), by creating a new paragraph (vi),
10 (e)(ii) and by creating a new paragraph (iii) is amended to
11 read:

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13 **21-16-1307. Success curriculum; test standards.**

15 (b) The success curriculum required to qualify for
16 honor or performance scholarship eligibility under this

1 article for students graduating from high school in the
2 2010-2011 school year and each school year thereafter shall
3 be as follows:

5 (vi) Effective school year 2015-2016:

7 (A) Fine and performing arts - two (2)
8 years of instruction in fine and performing arts, all of
9 which shall be taken in grades nine (9) through twelve
10 (12); or

12 (B) Career-vocational education - two (2)
13 years of instruction in career-vocational education, all of
14 which shall be taken in grades nine (9) through twelve
15 (12).

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17 (d) The success curriculum required to qualify for
18 opportunity scholarship eligibility under this article for
19 students graduating from high school in the 2010-2011
20 school year and each school year thereafter shall be as
21 follows:

23 (v) Except as provided by subsection (vi) of
24 this subsection, foreign language - demonstrate proficiency

1 on the state standards for the foreign cultures and
2 languages common core of knowledge requirement under W.S.
3 21-9-101(b)(i)(K) which may include American sign language
4 as one (1) component of foreign language proficiency;

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6 (vi) Effective school year 2015-2016 and each
7 school year thereafter, and in lieu of paragraph (v) of
8 this subsection, one (1) of the following:

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10 (A) Foreign language - two (2) sequenced
11 years of the same foreign language which need not be taken
12 consecutively, at least one (1) of which shall be taken in
13 grades nine (9) through twelve (12), or two (2) sequenced
14 years of instruction in the native language of the Eastern
15 Shoshone or the Northern Arapahoe, or two (2) sequenced
16 years of instruction in American sign language, either of
17 which need not be taken consecutively but at least one (1)
18 year of which is taken in grades nine (9) through twelve
19 (12); or

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21 (B) Fine and performing arts - two (2)
22 years of instruction in fine and performing arts, all of
23 which shall be taken in grades nine (9) through twelve
24 (12); or

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(C) Career-vocational education - two (2) years of instruction in career-vocational education, all of which shall be taken in grades nine (9) through twelve (12).

(e) The success curriculum required to qualify for provisional opportunity scholarship eligibility under this article for students graduating from high school in the 2010-2011 school year and each school year thereafter shall be the curriculum required for high school graduation under W.S. 21-2-304(a)(iii) subject to the following:

(ii) Except as provided in paragraph (iii) of this subsection, demonstration of proficiency on the state standards for the foreign cultures and languages common core of knowledge requirement under W.S. 21-9-101(b)(i)(K) which may include American sign language as one (1) component of foreign language proficiency;~~:-~~

(iii) Effective school year 2015-2016 and each school year thereafter, and in lieu of paragraph (ii) of this subsection, instruction in one (1) of the following:

1 (A) Foreign language - two (2) sequenced
2 years of the same foreign language which need not be taken
3 consecutively, at least one (1) of which shall be taken in
4 grades nine (9) through twelve (12), or two (2) sequenced
5 years of instruction in the native language of the Eastern
6 Shoshone or the Northern Arapahoe, or two (2) sequenced
7 years of instruction in American sign language, either of
8 which need not be taken consecutively but at least one (1)
9 year of which is taken in grades nine (9) through twelve
10 (12); or

12 (B) Fine and performing arts - two (2)
13 years of instruction in fine and performing arts, all of
14 which shall be taken in grades nine (9) through twelve
15 (12); or

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17 (C) Career-vocational education - two (2)
18 years of instruction in career-vocational education, all of
19 which shall be taken in grades nine (9) through twelve
20 (12).
