Livestock board; powers generally. 2 3 (a) In addition to powers and duties hereinafter 4 provided, the Wyoming livestock board shall: 5 6 (xii) Establish a standard communication protocol to inform livestock producers, veterinarians and 7 8 brand inspectors in the designated surveillance area within the county where a non-negative brucellosis test has been 9 10 confirmed for any animal. 11 12 11-18-117. Confidentiality of livestock premises and identification records; penalties. 13 14 15 Wyoming livestock board may release any (b) The 16 information related to a confirmed non-negative brucellosis 17 test in the county where the animal testing non-negative is located, subject to W.S. 11-18-103(a)(xii), and may release 18 19 information collected for the purposes of a livestock 20 identification program related to the ownership location of individual animals to the 21 extent the 22 information is useful in controlling or preventing a

disease outbreak or to show particular animals or herds are

1 involved in a disease outbreak. The information not 2 released may be a public release or may be limited to specific individuals with a need to know the information, 3 4 as the livestock board deems the circumstances require. 5 6 11-19-102. Duty of public to report diseases; list of 7 reportable diseases; failure to comply or obstruction of 8 duty; liability; penalties. 9 10 (f) Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this section, 11 the state veterinarian shall provide testing information to the owner of an animal that has tested non-negative for 12 brucellosis not later than three (3) days after receipt of 13 the preliminary laboratory results. 14

Section 2. The Wyoming livestock board shall promulgate all rules necessary to implement the provisions of this act.
