## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to the administration of government;
- 2 creating a task force to study and make recommendations on
- 3 federal funding as specified; requiring a report; providing
- 4 appropriations; and providing for an effective date.

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6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

8 Section 1.

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- 10 (a) There is created an advisory task force known as
- 11 the federal funds task force consisting of the following
- 12 members:

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1 (i) Two (2) members of the Wyoming senate appointed by the president of the senate not later than 2 3 March 31, 2015, one (1) of whom shall be designated as 4 cochairman; 5 6 (ii) Two (2) members of the Wyoming house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house not 7 later than March 31, 2015, one (1) of whom shall be 8 designated as cochairman; 9 10 11 (iii) Three (3) members appointed by the 12 governor not later than March 31, 2015. 13 14 (b) The task force shall be staffed by the 15 legislative service office. State agencies shall provide 16 information and assistance to the task force as requested. 17 The task force shall hold at least four (4) public meetings 18 each year. 19 20 (c) The taskforce shall study the following,

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related to federal funding:

1 (i) The financial stability of the federal 2 government; 3 4 (ii) The level of dependency the state and its 5 local governments have on the receipt of federal funds; 6 7 (iii) The risk that the state and its local 8 governments will experience a reduction in the amount or value of federal funds received, in both the near and 9 10 distant future; 11 12 (iv) The likely and potential impact on the state and its citizens from a reduction in the amount or 13 value of federal funds received by the state or its local 14 governments, in both the near and distant future; 15 16 17 (v) The likely and potential national impact from a reduction in the amount or value of federal funds 18 19 paid to the states, in both the near and distant future. 20 21 (d) The task force shall make recommendations on 22 methods to accomplish the following, as related to federal funding: 23

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2 (i) Avoid or minimize the risk of a reduction in

3 the amount or value of federal funds by the state and its

4 local governments;

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6 (ii) Reduce the dependency of the state and its

7 local governments on federal funds;

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9 (iii) Prepare for and respond to a reduction in

10 the amount or value of federal funds by the state and its

11 local governments.

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13 (e) The task force shall regularly provide updates to

14 the joint appropriations interim committee on the

15 activities of the task force. The task force shall submit

16 a final report including its final recommendations and any

17 proposed legislation with respect to the issues specified

18 in subsections (c) and (d) of this section to the joint

19 appropriations interim committee and the governor no later

20 than November 30, 2016. The joint appropriations interim

21 committee shall consider the recommendations and develop

22 legislation it deems appropriate for consideration by the

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23 legislature.

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- 2 (f) The task force shall exist until December 31,
- 3 2016. Members of the task force who are not state
- 4 employees or legislators shall not receive a salary but
- 5 shall receive reimbursement for mileage and per diem
- 6 expenses at the rate provided for legislators under W.S.
- 7 28-5-101. Members of the task force who are legislators
- 8 shall be paid salary, per diem and mileage as provided in
- 9 W.S. 28-5-101 for their official duties as members of the
- 10 task force.

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- 12 (g) There is appropriated from the general fund for
- 13 the purposes of this act:

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- 15 (i) Twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00) to the
- 16 legislative service office for payment of salary, per diem
- 17 and mileage for legislative task force members;

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- 19 (ii) Ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) to the
- 20 governor's office for payment of authorized per diem and

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21 mileage for nonlegislative task force members.

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1 (h) Funds appropriated under subsection (g) of this

section shall only be expended for the purposes of this

3 act. Any unused and unobligated funds shall revert as

4 provided by law on June 30, 2017.

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6 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon

7 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

8 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

9 Constitution.
