1 The definitions contained in this chapter apply to 2 words and phrases used in this Election Code and govern the 3 construction of those words and phrases unless they are 4 specifically modified by the context in which they appear. As used in this Election Code: 5 6 7 (xxvi) "Qualified elector" includes every citizen of the United States who is a bona fide resident of Wyoming, 8 9 has registered to vote and will be at least eighteen (18) 10 years of age on the day of the election at which he may offer to vote. No person is a qualified elector who does not show 11 12 a current, valid photo identification before voting, who is 13 a currently adjudicated mentally incompetent person, or who 14 has been convicted of a felony and his civil or voting rights have not been restored. A literacy test shall not be imposed 15 16 as a condition to voting in any election; 17 18 "Acceptable identification" (xxxix) means 19 current, valid photo identification and may also include one 20 (1) of the identification documents or other proof of identity 21 as specified by rule of the secretary of state as adequate 22 proof of the identity of a voter;
