3 private sector, every state employee with an annual salary

4 of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) or more shall

6 <u>duration</u> of the emergency. This subsection shall not

7 <u>include the state epidemiologist or the state health</u>

8 officer who will need to be available to declare an end to

9 the public health emergency.
