9 **Section 1.** W.S. 36-5-118 is created to read:

11 36-5-118. Special use permits; rules.

- 13 (a) The board shall establish rules and regulations
- 14 governing the issuance of special use permits for the
- 15 disposal of produced and fresh water on lands leased under

- 1 this chapter or on any state lands in connection with oil
- 2 and gas operations. The rules established under this
- 3 section shall at a minimum provide that:

- 5 (i) An opportunity for public comment is
- 6 provided before the issuance of a special use permit for
- 7 the disposal of produced and fresh water; and

- 9 (ii) The rates charged by the board for the
- 10 disposal of produced and fresh water shall not be less than
- 11 the fair market value of the right to dispose the water,
- 12 taking into account the type of well and the type and
- 13 amount of water used or produced to be disposed;

- 15 (iii) The terms "produced water" and "fresh
- 16 water" are defined.

- 18 (b) The disposal and any rules promulgated under this
- 19 subsection shall comply with all applicable federal and
- 20 state laws and all applicable rules of the department of
- 21 environmental quality and the oil and gas conservation
- 22 commission concerning disposals into disposal and injection

1 2 **Section 2.** W.S. 36-6-101(b) is amended to read: 3 4 36-6-101. Terms of leases; extensions; rules regulations; rent and royalties; assignment of leases; 5 grazing and agricultural leases; cooperation with United 6 7 States or its lessees, in cooperative or unit plans. 8 9 The board is further authorized to make and (b) 10 establish rules and regulations governing the issuance of 11 oil and gas, coal and other mineral leases and covering the 12 conduct of development and mining operations. The rules 13 shall provide for the disposal of produced and fresh water in connection with oil and gas leases issued under this 14 section as provided by W.S. 36-5-118. 15 16 17 Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 18 19 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the 20 Constitution. 21
