5	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7	Section 1. W.S. 30-5-115 is amended to read:

9	30-5-115. Permit required to drill well; notices;
10	fee.

12	<u>(a)</u> A person desiring to drill a well in search of
13	oil or gas shall notify the commission of such intent on a
13 14	oil or gas shall notify the commission of such intent on a form prescribed by the commission, and shall pay a fee

1	30-5-104(a) for a permit for each well. Upon receipt of
2	notification and the fee, the commission shall promptly
3	issue such person a permit to drill, unless the drilling of
4	the well is contrary to law, or to a rule, regulation, or
5	order of the commission. The drilling of a well is
б	prohibited until a permit to drill is obtained in
7	accordance with the provisions of this act.
8	
9	(b) Before issuing a permit under this section, the
10	commission may require a person desiring to drill a well to
11	provide notice to persons located within a reasonable
12	distance from the well. If notice is required pursuant to
13	this subsection:
14	
15	(i) The commission shall in rule establish the
16	reasonable distance from the well in which notice is
17	required which shall not be more than one-half (1/2) mile
18	from the well;
19	
20	(ii) The notice shall be sent by postcard,
21	include only a summary of the plan of work and proposed
22	dates of drilling and identify how further information
23	about the work may be obtained;

1 (iii) The notice shall be sent by first class 2 United States mail to all landowners located within the 3 4 established distance from the well; 5 6 (iv) If the well is located within a municipality, the notice shall also be sent to the 7 governing body of the municipality by certified mail. 8 9 Section 2.
