(b) The speaker of the house of representatives shall 1 2 appoint the house members of the select committee not later 3 than March 20, 2017, one (1) of whom the speaker shall designate as cochairman. Not more than five (5) members 4 5 from the house of representatives shall be from the same political party. The president of the senate shall appoint 6 the senate members of the select committee not later than 7 8 March 20, 2017, one (1) of whom the president shall designate as cochairman. Not more than five (5) members 9 10 from the senate shall be from the same political party. 11 12 The select committee shall study and recommend 13 solutions to the projected budget shortfall for funding 14 related to public education in the state of Wyoming. The 15 recommendations shall consider solutions necessary to 16 provide funding for schools until the next recalibration of the education resource block grant model under W.S. 17 21-13-309(t). The select committee shall focus on four (4) 18 major issues related to school funding as follows: 19 20 21 (i) The potential for reductions in education 22 spending;

1 (ii) Options for use of existing funds; 2 3 (iii) Consideration of diversions of existing 4 revenue streams and investment income; 5 (iv) Options to increase revenues including 6 options that are time limited until the next recalibration 7 8 of the education resource block grant model under W.S. 9 21-13-309(t). 10 11 The select committee shall also study (d) 12 recommend options for permanent funding solutions 13 school capital construction and major maintenance. 14 15 The select committee may form subcommittees to (e) 16 study any of the issues specified in subsection (c) of this section and any other issue within the select committee's 17 18 purview. 19 20 (f) The select committee shall solicit input and 21 recommendations from the school finance data advisory 22 committee established under W.S. 21-2-203(d) related to the issues specified in subsection (c) of this section. The 23

1 school finance data advisory committee shall report to the

2 select committee within the timelines specified by the

3 cochairmen in order for the report of the school finance

4 data advisory committee to be considered.

The governor shall appoint four (4) advisory 6 groups to provide input and recommendations to the select 7 8 committee. The state superintendent shall appoint one (1) member to each advisory group. The governor and state 9 10 superintendent shall consult with the Wyoming school boards 11 association prior to appointing members of the advisory 12 groups and the governor shall ensure that the members of 13 the advisory groups include stakeholders representing school districts, teachers, parents of students, 14 15 businesses of one hundred (100) employees or less, large 16 businesses of more than one hundred (100) employees and the 17 general public, provided that no one (1) group shall be 18 required to include representatives of all stakeholders. 19 Each member of an advisory group who is not a state 20 employee may receive per diem and mileage for attending and traveling to and from select committee or subcommittee 21 22 meetings in the same manner and amount as state employees.

1 The select committee shall be staffed by the (h) 2 legislative service office. The department of education, 3 the department of revenue, the school facilities division 4 of the state construction department, the school facilities commission and the state budget division of the department 5 of administration and information shall serve 6 advisory capacity to the select committee and shall provide 7 8 technical and other information to the select committee 9 upon request. 10 11 (j) The select committee shall introduce legislation 12 consistent with its recommendations to the legislature for 13 consideration during the next session of the legislature. 14 The select committee may, if it determines necessary, recommend to the governor and the presiding officers of the 15 16 house and senate that the legislature convene in a special session prior to the 2018 budget session to consider 17 18 legislation recommended by the select committee.

20 (k) The select committee may seek out expert opinions 21 related to the issues specified in subsections (c) and (d) 22 of this section and may hire consultants as necessary to

complete the study and recommendations required under this 1 2 section. 3 4 (m) The select committee, including meetings of subcommittees, shall meet not less than seven (7) times 5 during the 2017 interim throughout the state in locations 6 determined by the cochairmen. To the extent practical, the 7 8 select committee or a subcommittee of the select committee shall meet at least once in each of the seven 9 (7) appointment districts as provided in W.S. 9-1-218(b). 10 11 12 The select committee shall complete its work and recommendations not later than September 1, 2017. 13 14 The select committee created by this section 15 16 shall exist until December 31, 2018. 17 Section 2. 18 19 20 There is appropriated one hundred nine thousand (a) 21 dollars (\$109,000.00) from the general fund to the 22 legislative service office. This appropriation shall be for

the period beginning with the effective date of this act

2 expended for the purposes of the select committee on

3 education funding expenses as provided in section 1 of this

4 act. Any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this

5 appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30,

8 (b) There is appropriated forty-six thousand dollars

9 (\$46,000.00) from the general fund to the governor's

10 office. This appropriation shall be for the period

11 beginning with the effective date of this act and ending

12 June 30, 2019. This appropriation shall only be expended

13 for the purpose of providing reimbursement for advisory

14 group members under subsection (g) of section 1 of this

15 act. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this

16 appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any

17 other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds

18 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided

19 by law on June 30, 2019.

Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
