2 prepare and certify a report of licenses sold or issued in

3 the previous calendar year under the following statutes:

5 (iv) W.S. 23-1-705(a), (d), and (e) and (h); and

7 23-1-705. Complimentary licenses; one-shot antelope

8 hunt licenses; gunpowder and buckskin hunt licenses;

9 gratuitous licenses.

11 (h) In addition the commission may, upon receipt of

12 payment of antelope license fees, issue up to a total of

13 thirty (30) complimentary antelope licenses each year for

14 the exclusive distribution by nonprofit organizations

15 dedicated to providing hunting opportunities to individuals

16 with disabilities for use by those individuals for hunting

17 opportunities.
