State or national criminal history record 11 12 information. 13 (a) The following persons shall be required to submit 14 to fingerprinting in order to obtain state and national 15 16 criminal history record information: 17 18 (xxiii) Health care professionals applying for 19 licensure under title 33 of the Wyoming statutes, if 20 required as a condition for licensure pursuant to an 21 interstate compact entered into by the state of Wyoming. 22
