1 AN ACT relating to publication of legal notices; creating the

2 statewide official notices website; requiring publication of

3 legal notices on the official notices website rather than in

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8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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10 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-2-1038 and 9-2-1039 are created to

11 read:

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9-2-1038. Statewide official notices website.

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1	(a) The secretary of state shall create and administer
2	a website for the publication of legal notices. The website
3	shall be known and may be cited as the "statewide official
4	notices website."
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6	(b) The statewide official notices website shall:
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8	(i) Allow a person who has internet access to use
9	the website without paying a fee;
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11	(ii) Accept from any person official notice
12	postings as required by law or regulation:
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14	(A) Using a form prescribed by the secretary
15	of state that collects information to enable posting in
16	conformation with statutory notice requirements;
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18	(B) Without paying a fee.
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20	(iii) Allow for notice publishing categories that
21	include sections for statewide and individual counties,
22	municipalities and political subdivisions as required by law
23	or regulation;

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1 2 (iv) Allow for reposting of a notice on the dates 3 or frequency required by law or regulation to ensure that 4 notices continue to be displayed for not less than the length of time required by the relevant provision of law or 5 regulation; 6 7 8 (v) Allow viewing of notices by date and enable sorting of notices statewide or by county, municipality, 9 10 political subdivision or other region; 11 12 (vi) Enable notices, both current and archived, to be accessed by key word, party name, case number, county or 13 14 other useful identifiers; 15 16 (vii) Have a unique and simplified website 17 address; 18 19 (viii) Be directly accessible via a link from the

main page of the official state website;

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(ix) Include other links, features or functions

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2 that will assist a person in submitting, sorting and viewing 3 notices. 4 5 (c) The secretary of state shall: 6 7 (i) Establish and maintain the website, including 8 providing equipment, resources and personnel as necessary; 9 10 (ii) Coordinate and process the receipt and 11 posting of official public notices; 12 13 (iii) Maintain an archive of all information posted to the statewide official notices website; 14 15 16 (iv) Cause the website to be indexed by one (1) or 17 more search engines. 18 19 (d) Not later than July 1, 2020, the statewide official 20 notices website shall be operational. 21 (e) Not later than August 1, 2020 and not later than 22 August 1 each year beginning in 2021 through 2025, the 23

- 22 (a) The secretary of state shall adopt rules to
- 23 establish procedures for obtaining, submitting, reporting,

- 1 storing and providing official notices on the statewide
- 2 official notices website.

- 4 (b) All court, state, county, municipality and other
- 5 political subdivision rules and regulations shall specify
- 6 that notice by publication means publishing on the statewide
- 7 official notices website created by W.S. 9-2-1038(a) for not
- 8 less than the length of time required by the law or regulation
- 9 that requires the notice.

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11 Section 2. W.S. 8-1-110 is created to read:

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- 8-1-110. Recognition of legal notices published on the
- 14 statewide official notices website.

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- 16 If newspaper publication of legal notices is allowed or
- 17 required by law or regulation, posting the notice on the
- 18 statewide official notices website created by W.S.
- 19 9-2-1038(a) satisfies the law or regulation.

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21 **Section 3.** W.S. 1-6-201 through 1-6-203 are amended to

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22 read:

1 1-6-201. Manner of publishing generally.

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3 All notices by law directed, authorized or permitted to be 4 made by publication may shall be published on the statewide 5 official notices website created by W.S. 9-2-1038(a) once and reposted each week during the period of time for which the 6 notice is required by law to be published. All such weekly 7 publications may also be made in a newspaper. If the newspaper 8 9 <u>is</u> issued more than once each week <u>the notice</u> shall be 10 published in the same issue in each succeeding week for the

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13 1-6-202. Notice for certain number of days.

required publication period.

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Whenever the law requires or permits the publication of a 15 16 notice for a certain number of days prior to before any action, unless otherwise provided by law the publication may 17 <u>shall</u> be made <u>on the statewide official notices website</u> 18 19 <u>created by W.S. 9-2-1038(a) and reposted</u> weekly as provided 20 in W.S. 1-6-201, and as often as such weekly publication can 21 be made during the period of time for which such publication is required by law to be made, the first publication to be 22

1 made as many days prior to such before the action as the law

2 requires.

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4 1-6-203. Notice for specified number of weeks.

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6 In all cases where under the laws a notice is required or 7 permitted to be published for a specified number of weeks, it

8 is sufficient that the publication be made on the statewide

9 official notices website created by W.S. 9-2-1038(a) once

10 each week for the number of issues weeks corresponding to the

11 number of weeks for which such publication is required to be

12 made, provided that not more than twenty (20) days shall

13 intervene between the date of the last publication and the

14 time set for the intended action. In no case shall the notice

15 given for a longer time than required by law be held defective

16 for that reason.

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session the joint judiciary interim committee shall review publication requirements for legal notices in the Wyoming statutes and recommend statutory changes to provide that posting on the statewide official notices website created by

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2 specified notices.

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- 4 **Section 5.** There is appropriated fourteen thousand five
- 5 hundred dollars (\$14,500.00) from the general fund to the
- 6 secretary of state. This appropriation shall be for the period
- 7 beginning with the effective date of this act and ending June
- 8 30, 2020. This appropriation shall only be expended for the
- 9 purposes of carrying out the provisions of W.S. 9-2-1038 and
- 9-2-1039, as created in this act.

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- 14 (a) Sections 1, 4 and 5 of this act are effective
- 15 immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill
- 16 to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the
- 17 Wyoming Constitution.

- 20 2020.
