

## HOUSE BILL NO. HB0263

Senior citizen district elections.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to senior citizen service districts;  
2 amending the length of time that electors may authorize  
3 mill levy funding for districts; amending term lengths for  
4 district board members; providing for staggered board  
5 member elections; and providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 18-15-102(d) and 18-15-105(b) and by  
10 creating a new subsection (c) are amended to read:

12 **18-15-102. Formation of district; mill levy.**

13

14 (d) If the proposition to authorize a mill levy is  
15 approved by the qualified electors of the proposed

1 district, the proposition to impose a levy in the same or  
2 at a different amount not to exceed two (2) mills, shall be  
3 submitted to the resident electors within the proposed  
4 district at the first general election held two (2) years  
5 after the election authorizing the district and ~~at each~~  
6 ~~general election~~ every four (4) years thereafter, until  
7 defeated. If the proposition to impose or continue a mill  
8 levy is defeated, the proposition shall not be submitted to  
9 the electors for a period of not less than one (1) year.

11 **18-15-105. Election of trustees; generally.**

12  
13 (b) Members of the board shall be elected at the  
14 general election immediately following the primary election  
15 establishing the district. ~~and at each general election~~  
16 ~~thereafter, until the proposition establishing the district~~  
17 ~~is defeated.~~ At the first board election, three (3) members  
18 shall be elected for two (2) year terms and two (2) members  
19 shall be elected for four (4) year terms and until their  
20 successors are elected and qualified at the regular  
21 scheduled subsequent board election. Thereafter, members  
22 shall be elected for terms of four (4) years.

(c) For districts existing prior to July 1, 2017, at the first subsequent board election after the effective date of this act, three (3) members shall be elected for two (2) year terms and two (2) members shall be elected for four (4) year terms. Thereafter, members shall be elected for terms of four (4) years.

8           **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2017.
