A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to game and fish; increasing certain fees 2 relating to game and fish licenses, preference points, 3 permits, applications, and stamps; increasing certain 4 watercraft fees administered by the game and fish 5 department; and providing for an effective date.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 8

9 Section 1. W.S. 23-1-702, 23-2-101(e), (f)(i) through (iii), (j)(i) through (iv), (vi) through (x), (xiii) 10 11 through (xv), (xviii), (xix), (xxii) through (xxvii), (xxx), (xxxi), (xxxiv), (xxxv), (xxxix), (xliii) (A), (B), 12 13 (xlvi) and (m), 23-2-107(e), 23-2-201(d)(i), (ii) and (viii), 23-2-301(c)(i) through (xii), 23-2-306(b)(intro), 14 15 23-2-307(b), 41-13-104(f), (k) and (m) and 41-13-109(a)(i) 16 and (ii) are amended to read:

23-1-702. Duplicate license upon loss or destruction 2 3 of original; issuance; fees. 4 When any license issued under this act has been lost or 5 destroyed, the licensee may secure a duplicate of the 6 original license from any district office or any authorized 7 8 personnel of the department upon the presentation of 9 satisfactory proof that the original license was lost or 10 destroyed. Prior to issuing the duplicate license and in 11 accordance with rule and regulation of the commission, the 12 department may assess a fee of not more than three dollars (\$3.00) five dollars (\$5.00) plus the fee fees charged 13 under W.S. 23-1-701. Duplicate licenses shall be issued in 14 15 accordance with procedure established by commission order. 16 17 23-2-101. Fees; restrictions; nonresident application fee; nonresident licenses; verification of 18 residency

(e) Resident and nonresident license applicants shall
pay an application fee in an amount specified by this
subsection upon submission of an application for purchase

of any limited quota drawing for big or trophy game license 1 2 or wild bison license. The resident application fee shall 3 be five dollars (\$5.00) and the nonresident application fee 4 shall be fourteen dollars (\$14.00) fifteen dollars 5 (\$15.00). The application fee is in addition to the fees prescribed by subsections (f) and (j) of this section and 6 by W.S. 23-2-107 and shall be payable to the department 7 either directly or through an authorized selling agent of 8 9 the department. At the beginning of each month, the 10 commission shall set aside all of the fees collected during 11 calendar year 1980 and not to exceed twenty-five percent 12 (25%) of the fees collected thereafter pursuant to this 13 subsection to establish and maintain a working balance of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00), to compensate 14 owners or lessees of property damaged by game animals and 15 16 game birds.

(f) Forty percent (40%) of available nonresident elk licenses, forty percent (40%) of available nonresident deer licenses and forty percent (40%) of available nonresident antelope licenses for any one (1) calendar year shall as established by the commission, be offered to nonresident applicants upon receipt of the fee prescribed by this

Seventy-five (75) of the nonresident deer 1 subsection. 2 licenses set aside pursuant to this subsection shall be 3 used for a national bow hunt for deer. The licenses 4 authorized by this subsection shall be offered by drawing to nonresident applicants prior to the drawing for the 5 remaining nonresident licenses issued. The licenses offered 6 under this subsection shall be issued in a manner 7 8 prescribed by rules and regulations promulgated by the 9 commission. Nothing in this subsection shall prohibit any 10 unsuccessful applicant for a nonresident license pursuant 11 to this subsection from submitting an application for any 12 licenses remaining after the drawing during the calendar 13 year in which the application under this subsection was submitted. The following fees shall be collected by the 14 department and are in addition to the nonresident license 15 16 fee for the appropriate big game species imposed under 17 subsection (j) of this section and the application fee imposed under subsection (e) of this section: 18

The rules may provide for the loss of all accumulated points 4 for persons failing to apply or to pay the in lieu fee in 5 6 two (2) consecutive calendar years. The fee for any program under this subsection for antelope, deer or elk 7 8 shall be established by rule and shall not exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00) seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) per species. 9 10 Payment of the fee shall be made in compliance with application dates. Nothing in this subsection authorizes 11 12 the commission to establish or retain a fee for resident 13 moose or resident ram bighorn sheep license preference points in addition to the fee established by subsection (k) 14 15 of this section or to establish rules for ram bighorn sheep 16 or moose preference point drawings in conflict with the 17 provisions of W.S. 23-1-703(b). For nonresident ram bighorn 18 sheep and nonresident moose licenses, the commission may 19 establish by rule a nonrefundable preference point fee to 20 be withheld from either the license fee remitted or 21 submitted separately when application for a license or preference point is made through electronic licensing and 22 23 may establish a fee in lieu of making application in an

amount greater than that established under subsection (k) 1 2 of this section, but neither fee shall exceed one hundred 3 dollars (\$100.00) one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00). 4 Fees established under this subsection may be set at lower 5 amounts for youth license applicants. 6 7 23-2-107. Wild bison licenses. 8 9 A resident applicant shall pay a license fee of (e) 10 four hundred dollars (\$400.00) four hundred twelve dollars (\$412.00) for a license to harvest any wild bison or two 11 12 hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) two hundred fifty-eight 13 dollars (\$258.00) for a license to harvest a female or calf 14 wild bison and shall pay the fee required by W.S. 23-2-101(e). Certificates of number may be renewed by the owner in the same manner 17 18 provided under this act for obtaining initial 19 certification.

21 (k) If any certificate of number is lost, mutilated 22 or becomes illegible, the owner of the motorboat for which 23 the certificate was issued may obtain a duplicate

1 certificate upon application to the department. The 2 department may set and collect payment of a fee for a 3 duplicate certificate not to exceed five dollars (\$5.00) 4 ten dollars (\$10.00).

(m) A person engaged in the manufacture or sale of 6 motorboats may, upon application to the department in the 7 8 manner and on forms prescribed by rule and regulation, obtain certificates of number for use in the testing or 9 10 demonstrating of these motorboats. The fee for each 11 registration under this subsection shall be fifteen dollars 12 (\$15.00) thirty dollars (\$30.00). The numbers assigned by certificates of number issued under this subsection shall 13 14 be temporarily placed on the watercraft to be tested or 15 demonstrated.
