W.S. 25-8-103 and 25-11-107 are amended to 10 read: 11 12 25-8-103. Conditions for admission; charges for care. 13 (a) Admission to the pioneer home and the Wyoming 14 retirement center shall be voluntary and only upon prior 15 16 approval by the department of health. W.S. 25-11-107(b), indigent aged persons may be cared for 1 2 without charge. Nonindigent aged persons may be cared for 3 under terms and conditions fixed by the department pursuant 4 to <u>subsection (b) of this section and</u> W.S. 25-11-101 through 5 25-11-108. 6 7 (b) Revenues received from residents of the pioneer 8 home under W.S. 25-11-101 through 25-11-108 shall, on June 30 of each year, equal or exceed all operational costs of the 9 10 pioneer home which are borne by the state of Wyoming. As used 11 in this subsection, "operational costs" include personnel 12 expenses, equipment and maintenance expenses, but shall not 13 include capital construction. 14 25-11-107. State to bear costs of those unable to pay. 15 16 (a) Except as otherwise provided by subsection (b) of 17 this section, if a resident or legally responsible person has 18 19 no available assets at the time of or during the resident's 20 stay at a state institution to pay an established charge, all 21 costs of treatment and transportation shall be borne by the 22 state.
