1 A JOINT RESOLUTION requesting Congress submit to the states 2 a proposed amendment to the United States Constitution 3 requiring a balanced budget except in times of war or 4 declared national emergency.

6 WHEREAS, the necessity, importance and benefit of a7 balanced budget is evident; and

8

9 WHEREAS, Congress is expected to use its full range of 10 legislative powers to reach and maintain a balanced budget; 11 and

13 WHEREAS, continued deficit spending demonstrates an 14 unwillingness or inability of the federal executive and

1 legislative branches to spend no more than the available 2 revenues; and 3 4 WHEREAS, fiscal irresponsibility at the federal level is 5 lowering the standard of living, destroying jobs, inflating the currency and endangering economic opportunities now and 6 for the next generation; and 7 8 9 WHEREAS, the requirement for maintaining a balanced budget should be subject to waiver in times of declared war or 10 11 when two-thirds of both Houses of Congress and the President declare a national emergency. 12 13 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THELEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING: 15 16 17 Section 1. That procedures be instituted in Congress to add a new Article to the Constitution of the United 18 States, and that Congress prepare and submit to the several 19 20 states an amendment to the United States Constitution, 21 requiring that in the absence of a declared national 22 emergency or war, the total of all expenditures for any

23 fiscal year shall not exceed the total of estimated

revenues, excluding any revenues derived from borrowing,
for that fiscal year.

4 Section 2. That the Secretary of State of Wyoming 5 transmit copies of this resolution to the President of the United States, to the President of the Senate and the 6 Speaker of the House of Representatives of the United 7 States Congress, legislative leadership of the other forty-8 9 nine (49) states and to the Wyoming Congressional 10 Delegation, with a request that the Wyoming Congressional 11 delegation take all reasonable and necessary actions to initiate the amendment process to amend the Constitution of 12 the United States consistent with this resolution and that 13 this resolution be officially entered in the Congressional 14 record as a memorial to the Congress of the United States 15 of America. 16
