9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING, 10 two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting 11 separately, concurring therein:

13 **Section 1.** The following proposal to amend Wyoming 14 Constitution, Article 3, Section 52(c)(ii) is proposed for 15 submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the 16 next general election for approval or rejection to become

valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a majority 1 2 of the electors at the election: 3 4 Article 3, Section 52. Initiative and referendum. 5 (c) After certification of the application, a petition 6 containing a summary of the subject matter shall be prepared 7 8 by the secretary of state for circulation by the sponsors. 9 The petition may be filed with the secretary of state if it 10 meets both of the following requirements: 11 12 (ii) It is signed by qualified voters equal in number to fifteen percent (15%) of those resident in at least 13 two-thirds (2/3) of the counties senate districts of the 14 state, as determined by those who voted in the preceding 15 16 general election in that county each senate district. 17 18 Section 2. That the Secretary of State shall endorse 19 the following statement on the proposed amendment: 20 21 The Wyoming Constitution allows the people of the state to 22 propose and enact laws by initiative and to approve or reject 23 acts of the legislature by referendum. This amendment would

2	initiative or referendum. Currently, a petition must be
3	signed by at least fifteen percent (15%) of the qualified
4	voters in at least two-thirds (2/3) of the counties. This
5	amendment would change the requirement to at least fifteen
б	percent (15%) of the qualified voters in at least two-thirds
7	(2/3) of the senate districts. This amendment will provide
8	for equal participation of Wyoming residents in the political
9	process by adhering to the "one person one vote" principle.
