valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a 1 majority of the electors at the election: 2 3 Article 17, Section 1. Of whom militia constituted. 4 5 The militia of the state shall consist of all able-bodied 6 7 qualified residents of the state, and those nonresidents who are accepted into service, between the ages of 8 9 seventeen (17) and seventy (70) years aged seventeen (17) years and above; except those exempted by the law of the 10 11 United States or of the state. But all residents having 12 scruples of conscience averse to bearing arms shall be 13 excused therefrom upon conditions as shall be prescribed by 14 law. 15 16 Section 2. That the Secretary of State shall endorse the following statement on the proposed amendment: 17 18
