A JOINT RESOLUTION commending to Congress the Federal
Communications Commission's efforts to solve rural call
completion problems.

5 WHEREAS, local phone service providers in rural areas have 6 reported an alarming increase in complaints from customers 7 that long distance calls and faxes are not reaching them; 8 and

10 WHEREAS, complaints of poor call quality and dropped calls 11 in rural areas are a persistent problem affecting eighty 12 percent (80%) of rural carriers; and

WHEREAS, the problems are associated with the decades old 1 2 system of "access" charges that help pay for the cost of 3 rural networks; and 4 5 WHEREAS, to minimize these charges some long distance carriers use third party "least cost routers" which attempt 6 to connect calls to their destinations at the lowest cost 7 possible; and 8 9 WHEREAS, the federal communications commission issued new 10 11 rules, effective December 29, 2011 which attempt to provide both short and long-term solutions to rural call completion 12 13 problems through prohibiting actions blocking, degrading or 14 choking off calls for any reason, including to avoid high 15 access charges; and 16 17 WHEREAS, the federal communications commission issued an order on February 6, 2012, clearly finding that certain 18 practices by long distance carriers causing rural call 19 completion problems constitute unjust and unreasonable 20 21 practices in violation of section 201 of the Communications 22 Act of 1934.

4 Section 1. That the legislature of the state of 5 Wyoming commends the federal communications commission for 6 its efforts to improve rural call completion and service 7 quality problems.

9 Section 2. That the legislature of the state of 10 Wyoming encourages the federal communications commission to 11 continue its efforts to improve rural telephone service and 12 to monitor the effects of its efforts closely.

That the Secretary of State of Wyoming 14 Section 3. transmit copies of this resolution to the President of the 15 United States, to the President of the Senate and the 16 Speaker of the House of Representatives of the United 17 Wyoming Congressional 18 States Congress and to the 19 Delegation.
