## A BILL

for

- 1 A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing to amend the Wyoming
- 2 Constitution by amending the classes of property for
- 3 property taxation purposes by authorizing the legislature
- 4 to limit the amount of property tax increase.

- 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,
- 7 two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting
- 8 separately, concurring therein:

- 10 Section 1. The following proposal to amend Wyoming
- 11 Constitution, Article 15, Section 11 by creating a new
- 12 subsection (e) is proposed for submission to the electors
- 13 of the State of Wyoming at the next general election for
- 14 approval or rejection to become valid as a part of the
- 15 Constitution if ratified by a majority of the electors at
- 16 the election:

2 Article 15, Section 11. Uniformity of assessment required.

- 5 (e) Notwithstanding the other provisions of this
- section, for any class of property valued under subsection 6
- (a) of this section, the legislature may: 7

- 9 (i) Determine the maximum amount of any ad
- valorem tax that can be collected; and 10

- 12 (ii) Prescribe restrictions upon the increase of
- 13 the rate of taxation or assessment.

- 15 Section 2. That the Secretary of State shall endorse
- the following statement on the proposed amendment: 16

- The adoption of this amendment will allow the legislature 18
- to determine the maximum amount of any property tax that 19
- 20 can be collected and prescribe restrictions upon
- 21 increase of the rate of taxation or assessment for all
- 22 classes of property.

Section 3. There is appropriated twenty-seven thousand 1 2 nine hundred dollars (\$27,900.00) from the general fund to 3 the secretary of state. This appropriation shall only be expended for the purpose of costs of publication required by 4 5 this act and W.S. 22-20-104. Notwithstanding any other 6 of law, this appropriation provision shall not 7 transferred or expended for any other purpose and remaining unobligated funds 8 unexpended, from appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 9 10 2012. This section is effective July 1, 2010.
