1 AN ACT relating to junk dealers; requiring photo
2 identification and vehicle license plate number to be
3 recorded by junk dealers; and providing for an effective
4 date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 33-18-102 is amended to read:

10 **33-18-102. Records; book to be kept.**

11

12 (a) Every person, ~~firm or corporation~~ engaged in the
13 junk business as defined in W.S. 33-18-101, shall keep a
14 book, in which all entries shall be written in ink, in the
15 English language and entered at the time of each and every

1 ~~sale,~~ transaction and in which the following information is
2 recorded:

3
4 (i) An accurate account and description,~~in the~~
5 ~~English language,~~ of all junk metal or rubber goods
6 purchased or sold; ~~and~~

8 (ii) The name and residence of the person
9 selling or buying the ~~same.~~ junk metal or rubber goods;

11 (iii) The license plate number of the person's
12 vehicle, if applicable; and

13
14 (iv) A photocopy of the person's United States
15 federal or state-issued photo identification, which
16 includes a driver's license, a United States passport, a
17 United States passport card or a United States military
18 identification card.

20 (b) No entry in such book shall be erased, mutilated
21 or changed.

1 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2015.
