A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to junk dealers; requiring photo  
2 identification and vehicle license plate number to be  
3 recorded by junk dealers; providing an exception; and  
4 providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 33-18-102 is amended to read:

10 **33-18-102. Records; book to be kept.**

11

12 (a) Every person, ~~firm or corporation~~ engaged in the  
13 junk business as defined in W.S. 33-18-101, shall keep a  
14 book, or dedicated computer software program in which all  
15 entries shall be written in a computer or in ink, in the  
16 English language and entered at the time of each and every

1 ~~sale,~~ transaction and in which the following information is  
2 recorded:

3  
4 (i) An accurate account and description,~~in the~~  
5 ~~English language,~~ of all junk metal or rubber goods  
6 purchased or sold; ~~and~~

7  
8 (ii) The name and residence of the person  
9 selling or buying the ~~same.~~ junk metal or rubber goods;

10  
11 (iii) The license plate number of the person's  
12 vehicle, if applicable; or

13  
14 (iv) A photocopy of the person's United States  
15 federal or state-issued photo identification, which  
16 includes a driver's license, a United States passport, a  
17 United States passport card or a United States military  
18 identification card.

20 (b) Compliance with paragraphs (iii) and (iv) of  
21 subsection (a) of this section is optional for common  
22 household and personal items of less than fifty dollars  
23 (\$50.00) market value.

2       (c) No entry in such book or computer shall be  
3 erased, mutilated or changed.

5       **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2015.
