A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to community colleges; modifying community
- 2 college major maintenance provisions; providing for
- 3 uniformity in the calculations for major maintenance
- 4 funding for community colleges; correcting references;
- 5 authorizing rulemaking; and providing for an effective
- 6 date.

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8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 10 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-5-107 by creating new subsections
- 11 (g) and (h) and 21-18-225(a), (e) through (g), (j), (k) and
- 12 by creating a new subsection (m) are amended to read:

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- 9-5-107. General services division; duties and
- 15 responsibilities with respect to state buildings; state

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16 capital construction needs assessment and priorities.

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1	(g) The state building commission shall adopt a
2	formula for major building and facility repair and
3	replacement for community college facilities. The formula
4	shall:
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6	(i) Be based on the gross square footage of
7	buildings and facilities for not more than seven (7)
8	categories of buildings and shall:
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10	(A) Include only buildings providing
11	education programs comprising the statewide college system
12	strategic plan developed and maintained under W.S.
13	<u>21-18-202(a)(v);</u>
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15	(B) Specifically exclude student housing,
16	student unions and auxiliary services areas funded
17	exclusively through community college generated revenues.
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19	(ii) Use a multiplier to maintain facilities in
20	fair condition based on criteria from organizations with
21	expertise in the area of major maintenance funding;
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23	(iii) Otherwise be computed in the same manner
24	as for major maintenance for school facilities under W.S.

- 2 R.S. Means construction cost index, as modified to reflect
- 3 current Wyoming construction costs determined by the
- 4 department of administration and information, division of
- 5 economic analysis, to calculate replacement cost.

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- 7 (h) As used in this section "major building and
- 8 facility repair and replacement" means the repair or
- 9 replacement of complete or major portions of building and
- 10 facility systems at irregular intervals which is:

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- 12 (i) Required to continue the use of the building
- 13 or facility at its original capacity for its original
- 14 intended use, including for compliance with the Americans
- 15 with Disabilities Act, and including installing fire
- 16 suppression systems in residential facilities; and

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- 18 (ii) Typically accomplished by contractors due
- 19 to the personnel demand to accomplish the work in a timely
- 20 manner, the level of sophistication of the work or the need
- 21 for warranted work.

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- 23 21-18-225. College maintenance and capital
- 24 construction funding.

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2 (a) As part of its administrative functions, the 3 community college commission shall identify community 4 college building needs and develop a prioritized list of 5 community college capital construction projects. prioritized community college capital construction projects 6 shall be reported by the commission to the construction 7 management program within the general services division of 8 9 the department of administration and information in accordance with subsection (g) of this section. Following 10 11 review, analysis and study, the construction management division program shall forward recommendations 12 13 community college capital construction projects to state building commission. The construction management 14 division program shall also submit major maintenance budget 15 requests for college buildings to the legislature 16 17 accordance with this section. Major maintenance budget requests shall be based upon the square footage submitted 18 by the commission under subsection (f) of this section and 19 upon a formula adopted by the state building commission, 20 21 and upon forms and in a format specified by the budget 22 division of the department of administration and information. College building maintenance budget requests 23 submitted by the construction management division program 24

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1 to the legislature and capital construction budget requests

2 forwarded by the state building commission to the

3 legislature shall include only necessary building square

4 footage:

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6 <u>(i) R</u>equired for provision of those education

7 programs comprising the statewide college system strategic

8 plan developed and maintained under W.S. 21-18-202(a)(v);

9 and

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11 (ii) For major maintenance, exclude student

12 housing, student unions and auxiliary services areas funded

13 exclusively through college generated revenues.

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15 (e) The commission may modify construction needs

16 prioritized under subsection (d) of this section in any

17 subsequent fiscal year as necessary to address statewide

18 needs as substantiated by data, condition assessments,

19 needs analysis and other information assembled by the

20 commission under this section. Needs receiving a lower

21 priority than previously assigned may be removed or

22 reprioritized by the commission. Construction needs

23 modified under this subsection shall be reported to the

24 construction management program of the general services

1 division of the department of administration and

2 information.

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In addition to subsection (d) of this section and 4 5 on or before August June 1 of each odd-numbered year, the commission shall report college building square footage to 6 the construction management program within the general 7 services division of the department of administration and 8 9 information as necessary for computation of major maintenance funds for community college buildings. 10 11 reported square footage shall be restricted to that square footage necessary for the delivery of education programs 12 13 comprising the statewide college system strategic plan and exclude student housing, student unions and auxiliary 14 services areas funded exclusively through college generated 15 16 revenues.

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(g) Upon prioritizing community college construction needs under subsection (d) of this section, the commission shall not later than August June 1 of each year, report the prioritized list to the construction management program of the general services division of the department of administration and information. In accordance with W.S. 9-5-108(a)(ii), the construction management division

program shall review, analyze and study construction needs 1 prioritized under subsection (d) of this section and 2 3 conduct necessary value engineering analysis, schematic 4 design review, safety and security assessments and other 5 analysis and review prior to submission of recommendations to the state building commission. The state building 6 incorporate shall consider and 7 commission prioritized construction needs recommendations into 8 legislation 9 requesting necessary funding, developed under W.S. 9-5-108(a)(ii)(J), for submission to the legislature for 10 11 review, authorization and approval. The legislation shall also include a separate appropriation for contingency costs 12 13 associated with recommended construction projects and a 14 separate appropriation for administrative costs of the construction management division program for management of 15 recommended construction projects as 16 the required by The 17 subsection (j) of this section. construction management division program shall submit a separate budget 18 request for project design and planning funds to be 19 available to assist community colleges with costs incurred 20 21 in developing and providing necessary plans, designs and 22 other information to the general services division for purposes of this subsection. 23 This request shall also 24 include funds for major maintenance for the square footage

1 reported by the commission under subsection (f) of this

2 section. The construction management division program shall

3 consult with the community college commission in developing

4 recommendations under this subsection.

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Subject to amounts made available by legislative 6 appropriation and to any conditions which may be attached 7 to appropriation expenditures, the construction management 8 9 division program of the department of administration and 10 information shall distribute state funds for building 11 construction approved and authorized by the legislature. Distributions of state funds for 12 any approved 13 authorized construction project shall be in accordance with payment schedules established by rule and regulation of the 14 Payments by the division program shall 15 division. contingent upon the receipt of any local district funding 16 17 as may be required by legislative authorization, or upon receipt of other documentation which may be required by the 18 division program certifying the timely receipt of required 19 local district funds for the capital construction project. 20 21 Payments to districts shall also be attached to prescribed 22 phases of the construction project and the completion of certain project phases. Construction phases for which 23 24 approval of the division program is required shall be

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specified by division department of administration and 1 2 information rule and regulation, clearly prescribing a 3 process for division program review and approval of project plans and specifications, project development and project 4 5 changes and change orders. In carrying out duties under subsection, the <u>division</u> construction management 6 this prescribed under program 7 may execute powers 9-5-108(a)(iii) in coordination with the state building 8 9 commission and the appropriate community college district. No scheduled payment shall be made by the construction 10 management division program without compliance with the 11 prescribed process. 12 13 14 Appropriations for major maintenance shall be (k) distributed by the construction management division program 15 16 within the general services division of the department of 17 administration and information to community colleges in amounts determined by the funding formula developed by the 18 general services division state building commission, 19 subject to restrictions imposed qualifying square 20 on 21 footage pursuant to this section.

23 (m) Notwithstanding any provision of law enacted 24 prior to January 1, 2014, biennial budget requests

3 legislature shall be calculated as provided in this
