A BILL

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 10 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-5-107 by creating new subsections
- 11 (q) and (h) and 21-18-225(a), (b) by creating a new
- 12 paragraph (iv), (e) through (g), (j), (k) and by creating a
- 13 new subsection (m) are amended to read:

- 9-5-107. General services division; duties and
- 16 responsibilities with respect to state buildings; state
- 17 capital construction needs assessment and priorities.

2	(g) The state building commission shall adopt a
3	formula for major building and facility repair and
4	replacement for community college facilities. The formula
5	shall:
6	
7	(i) Be based on the gross square footage of
8	buildings and facilities for not more than seven (7)
9	categories of buildings and shall:
10	
11	(A) Include only buildings providing
12	education programs comprising the statewide college system
13	strategic plan developed and maintained under W.S.
14	<u>21-18-202(a)(v);</u>
15	
16	(B) Specifically exclude student housing,
17	student unions and auxiliary services areas funded
18	exclusively through community college generated revenues.
19	
20	(ii) Use a multiplier to maintain facilities in
21	at least fair condition based on criteria from
22	organizations with expertise in the area of major
. —	

maintenance funding;

1	(iii) Otherwise be computed in the same manner
2	as for major maintenance for school facilities under W.S.
3	21-15-109, including using the most current edition of the
4	R.S. Means construction cost index, as modified to reflect
5	current Wyoming construction costs determined by the
6	department of administration and information, division of
7	economic analysis, to calculate replacement cost.
8	
9	(h) As used in this section "major building and
10	facility repair and replacement" means the repair or
11	replacement of complete or major portions of building and
12	facility systems at irregular intervals which is:
13	
14	(i) Required to continue the use of the building
15	or facility at its original capacity for its original
16	intended use, including for compliance with the Americans
17	with Disabilities Act, and including installing fire
18	suppression systems in residential facilities; and
19	
20	(ii) Typically accomplished by contractors due
21	to the personnel demand to accomplish the work in a timely
22	manner, the level of sophistication of the work or the need
23	for warranted work.

4 (a) As part of its administrative functions, the 5 community college commission shall identify community college building needs and develop a prioritized list of 6 community college capital construction projects. 7 prioritized community college capital construction projects 8 9 shall be reported by the commission to the construction management program within the general services division of 10 department of administration and information 11 accordance with subsection (g) of this section. Following 12 13 review, analysis and study, the construction management division program shall forward recommendations 14 community college capital construction projects to the 15 state building commission. The construction management 16 17 division program shall also submit major maintenance budget requests for college buildings to the legislature 18 accordance with this section. Major maintenance budget 19 requests shall be based upon the square footage submitted 20 by the commission under subsection (f) of this section and 21 upon a formula adopted by the state building commission, 22 and upon forms and in a format specified by the budget 23 24 division of the department of administration

9 on or before August June 1 of each odd-numbered year, the 10 commission shall report college building square footage to 11 the construction management program within the general services division of the department of administration and 12 13 information as necessary for computation of major maintenance funds for community college buildings. 14 reported square footage shall be restricted to that square 15 16 footage necessary for the delivery of education programs 17 comprising the statewide college system strategic plan and

The legislation shall 15 also include a separate appropriation for contingency costs 16 17 associated with recommended construction projects and a separate appropriation for administrative costs of the 18 construction management division program for management of 19 required 20 the recommended construction projects as 21 subsection (j) of this section. The construction 22 management division program shall submit a separate budget request for project design and planning funds to be 23 available to assist community colleges with costs incurred 24

Subject to amounts made available by legislative 10 (i) 11 appropriation and to any conditions which may be attached to appropriation expenditures, the construction management 12 13 division program of the department of administration and information shall distribute state funds for building 14 construction approved and authorized by the legislature. 15 16 Distributions of funds for approved state any 17 authorized construction project shall be in accordance with payment schedules established by rule and regulation of the 18 Payments by the <u>division</u> program shall be 19 division. contingent upon the receipt of any local district funding 20 21 as may be required by legislative authorization, or upon 22 receipt of other documentation which may be required by the division program certifying the timely receipt of required 23 local district funds for the capital construction project. 24

Payments to districts shall also be attached to prescribed 1 2 phases of the construction project and the completion of 3 certain project phases. Construction phases for which 4 approval of the division program is required shall be 5 specified by division department of administration and information rule and regulation, clearly prescribing a 6 process for division program review and approval of project 7 plans and specifications, project development and project 8 9 changes and change orders. In carrying out duties under 10 subsection, the <u>division</u> construction management 11 may execute powers prescribed under W.S. program 9-5-108(a)(iii) in coordination with the state building 12 13 commission and the appropriate community college district. 14 No scheduled payment shall be made by the construction management division program without compliance with the 15 prescribed process. 16

Appropriations for major maintenance shall be (k) distributed by the construction management division program within the general services division of the department of administration and information to community colleges in amounts determined by the funding formula developed by the general services division state building commission,

1 subject to restrictions imposed on qualifying square

4 (m) Notwithstanding any provision of law enacted

5 prior to January 1, 2014, biennial budget requests

6 submitted for major maintenance funding for community

7 college capital construction facilities authorized by the

8 legislature shall be calculated as provided in this

9 section.

11 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon

12 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

13 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

14 Constitution.
