A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to criminal procedure; providing for the
2 expungement of records of conviction of misdemeanors as
3 specified; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 7-13-1501(a)(intro) and (ii) is
8 amended to read:

10 **7-13-1501. Petition for expungement of records of**
11 **conviction of misdemeanors; filing fee; notice; objections;**
12 **hearing; definitions.**

14 (a) A person who has pleaded guilty or nolo
15 contendere to or been convicted of a misdemeanor ~~under W.S.~~

1 ~~6-2-501(a) or (b), 6-2-504(a), 6-2-510(a), 6-2-511(a) or~~
2 ~~6-6-102,~~ or ~~these same~~ misdemeanors arising out of the same
3 occurrence or related course of events, may petition the
4 convicting court for an expungement of the records of
5 conviction, subject to the following limitations:

7 (ii) Other than convictions for which an
8 expungement is sought under this section, the petitioner
9 has not previously pleaded guilty or nolo contendere to or
10 been convicted of a misdemeanor; ~~under W.S. 6-2-501(a) or~~
11 ~~(b), 6-2-504(a), 6-2-510(a), 6-2-511(a) or 6-6-102;~~

13 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2015.
