2 (v) Based upon ADM computations and identified 3 school configurations within each district pursuant to 4 paragraph (iv) of this subsection, compute the foundation program amount for each district as prescribed by the 5 education resource block grant model adopted by the Wyoming 6 legislature as defined under W.S. 21-13-101(a)(xiv), as 7 8 contained within the spreadsheets and accompanying reports referenced under W.S. 21-13-101(a)(xvii). The following 9 10 criteria shall be used by the state superintendent in the 11 administration of the education resource block grant model:
