A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the legislature; specifying authority of  
2 the legislature to employ staff; specifying conditions of  
3 employment; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 28-1-103, 28-3-103 and 28-4-103 are  
8 amended to read:

10 **28-1-103. Additional employees.**

11

12 At any time during the session of the legislature when the  
13 employment of additional persons may be necessary for the  
14 efficient performance of the duties imposed upon the  
15 legislature, the senate and house of representatives are  
16 hereby authorized to employ such additional employees. All

1 persons employed by either house shall at all times serve  
2 at the will of the presiding officer of that house.

3  
4 **28-3-103. Employees generally.**

5  
6 (a) At the beginning of each session of the  
7 legislature, the senate thereof shall engage such employee  
8 personnel for said session, upon respective compensation  
9 bases, as decided by it.

10  
11 (b) The senate may authorize personnel to be employed  
12 beyond the adjournment of the session in order to complete  
13 recordkeeping of each session and prepare for each session  
14 of the legislature. The president of the senate, subject  
15 to legislative appropriation, shall establish the  
16 compensation of any staff so employed whose duties shall be  
17 performed under the direction of the president.

18  
19 **28-4-103. Employees generally.**

20  
21 (a) At the beginning of each session of the  
22 legislature, the house of representatives thereof shall

1 engage such employee personnel for said session, upon  
2 respective compensation bases, as decided by it.

3  
4 (b) The house may authorize personnel to be employed  
5 beyond the adjournment of the session in order to complete  
6 recordkeeping of each session and prepare for each session  
7 of the legislature. The speaker of the house, subject to  
8 legislative appropriation, shall establish the compensation  
9 of any staff so employed whose duties shall be performed  
10 under the direction of the speaker.

11

12 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon  
13 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law  
14 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming  
15 Constitution.
