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1 Criminal history record information shall be (a) 2 disseminated by criminal justice agencies in this state, 3 whether directly or through any intermediary, only to: 4 5 (xv) The military department for purposes of obtaining criminal history record information including any 6 completed investigations on prospective employees, 7 or 8 volunteers or military members serving in active duty or in the Wyoming national guard. The dissemination of criminal 9 10 history record information authorized by this paragraph shall only occur if required by the department for a 11 12 position with the department, training decisions, 13 deployability, mobilization or security clearance; 14 7-19-201. State or national criminal history record 15 16 information. 17 18 The following persons shall be required to submit (a) 19 to fingerprinting in order to obtain state and national 20 criminal history record information: 21 22 (viii) Prospective employees of or volunteers 23 with the Wyoming military department or active duty or
