A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; creating a rebuttable
- 2 presumption relating to vehicles registered under the laws
- 3 of another jurisdiction for purposes of titling,
- 4 registration and ownership; providing a penalty; creating
- 5 a definition; amending vehicle registration exemptions; and
- 6 providing for effective dates.

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- 10 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-1-101(a) by creating a new
- 11 paragraph (xxxiv), 31-2-201 by creating new subsections (o)
- 12 through (q) and 31-2-224(a)(v)(intro) are amended to read:

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14 **31-1-101**. Definitions.

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1	(a) Except as otherwise provided, as used in this
2	act:
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4	(xxxiv) "Shell business" means any partnership,
5	limited liability company, limited liability partnership,
6	corporation or other legal entity organized under the laws
7	of another jurisdiction which owns or holds title to a
8	vehicle to avoid proper registration of the vehicle in this
9	state. Factors which may indicate a legal entity is a
LO	shell business include but are not limited to the
L1	following:

L3	(A) The primary business activity or
L 4	purpose of the legal entity is the avoidance of paying
L 5	Wyoming taxes and fees;
L 6	
L 7	(B) Failure to maintain a physical location
L 8	in the foreign jurisdiction for at least one (1) year.
L 9	Under no circumstances shall a registered agent be deemed
20	to provide the legal entity with a physical location;
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1	(C) Failure to employ individual persons
2	and provide those persons with internal revenue service
3	form W-2 wage and tax statements; or

5	(D) Failure to file or pay federal tax
6	returns or failure to file or pay a required state tax
7	return in the foreign jurisdiction;

9	(E) The business entity has not deducted
10	vehicle depreciation or expenses in a federal income tax
11	return.

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15	(o) If the department, in consultation with the
16	department of revenue, a county treasurer or a Wyoming
17	peace officer, determines a resident is in control of a
18	vehicle owned by a shell business, it shall be rebuttably
19	presumed the resident is the actual owner of the vehicle
20	and the resident shall be required to obtain a Wyoming
21	certificate of title, to register the vehicle and to pay
22	any sales or use taxes due on the purchase of the vehicle
23	in accordance with W.S. 39-15-107(b)(i) or

1	39-16-107(b)(ii). The department shall promulgate rules
2	and regulations to determine if a resident is in control of
3	a vehicle owned by a shell business which may include
4	consideration of the following factors:
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6	(i) The resident was the initial purchaser of
7	the vehicle;
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9	(ii) The resident operated or stored the vehicle
10	in Wyoming for any period of time;
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12	(iii) The resident is a partner, member or
13	shareholder of the shell business that purports to be the
14	owner of the vehicle; or

16	(iv) The resident is insured to drive the
17	vehicle.
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19	(p) If the department, in consultation with the
20	department of revenue, a county treasurer or a Wyoming
21	peace officer, determines that a resident is the presumed
22	owner of a vehicle under subsection (o) of this section,
23	the department shall notify the resident in writing, that

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the resident is required to obtain a Wyoming certificate of 1 2 title, to register the vehicle and to pay any sales or use 3 taxes due on the purchase of the vehicle in accordance with 4 W.S. 39-15-107 (b) (i) or 39-16-107 (b) (ii) within thirty (30) days from the date of the notice. The department shall 5 6 promulgate rules and regulations in accordance with the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act necessary to implement 7 this section, including rules and regulations to provide 8 9 the resident an opportunity for a hearing and appeal. 10 Following a final determination in the appeal in favor of the department, the resident shall owe the taxes and fees 11 12 determined to be due. 13 (q) If a person found to be in control of a vehicle 14 15 owned by a shell business under subsection (o) of this 16 section fails to pay registration fees or applicable sales 17 or use taxes due within thirty (30) days from the date of 18 the notice required under subsection (p) of this section or within thirty (30) days following a final determination in 19 20 favor of the department under subsection (p) of this 21 section, the person shall be charged a civil penalty in an 22 amount not more than seventy-five percent (75%) of the 23 unpaid registration fees.

Registration exemptions. 3 4 (a) The following vehicles are exempt from the provisions of this article: 5 6 7 (v) Except as otherwise provided in W.S. 31-2-101(o), vehicles owned by a nonresident, validly 8 9 registered in another state or country, displaying registration numbers or plates in accordance with the laws 10 of that state or country and: 11 12 13 Section 2. The department of transportation shall promulgate rules and regulations necessary to implement 14 this act on or before July 1, 2016. 15

4	section, this act is effective July 1, 2017.
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6	(b) Section 2 of this act is effective immediately
7	upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become
8	law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
