(a) A director of the Wyoming law enforcement academy
shall be appointed by the attorney general with the consent
of the governor. The director shall serve at the pleasure

1	of the attorney general. He shall have administrative and						
2	operational experience in criminal justice and such other						
3	qualifications as are satisfactory to the attorney general.						
4	The director, subject to approval of the attorney general,						
5	shall:

7	(i) Supervise and direct all activities of the						
8	law enforcement academy;

10	(ii) Establish policies and procedures to						
11	promote a safe, healthy and productive training						
12	environment;

14	(iii) Promulgate rules and regulations to ensure						
15	maintenance of a productive learning environment, which may						
16	include a code of conduct and disciplinary rules for						
17	students;

19	(iv) Establish standards for the satisfactory						
20	completion of classes and courses which shall comply with						
21	standards promulgated by the peace officers standards and						
22	training commission for peace officers, dispatchers and						
23	coroners.
