         (a) The geological survey board is created. The board
    consists of eight (8) members, including the governor, the
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    president of the University of Wyoming or his designee, the
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state oil and gas supervisor and five (5) members appointed 1 2 for four (4) year terms by the governor with the consent of 3 the senate., but not more than three (3) of whom shall be 4 from the same political party. The five (5) members shall 5 be qualified electors of the state who possess knowledge, experience and skill to qualify them for the 6 position. The governor may remove any appointed member as 7 8 provided in W.S. 9-1-202. Vacancies shall be filled by the governor for the unexpired term. The state geologist is an 9 10 ex officio member of the board. 11 12 9-3-404. Wyoming retirement board; responsibility for 13 administration of system; composition; appointment; term; vacancies; meetings; election of chairman. 14 15 16 The responsibility for the administration and (a) operation of the retirement system is vested solely and 17 18 exclusively in the Wyoming retirement board. The board 19 shall be composed of eleven (11) members, not more than six 20 (6)—seventy-five percent (75%) of whom shall be from the

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5 the (a) This act creates Wyoming community development authority. The authority is a body corporate 6 operating as a state instrumentality operated solely for 7 8 the public benefit. Its membership consists of ten (10) 9 directors, seven (7) of whom are appointed by the governor 10 with the advice and consent of the senate. Not more than 11 four (4) seventy-five percent (75%) of the appointed 12 directors shall be from the same political party. Directors 13 shall serve for staggered terms of four (4) years each. No appointed director shall serve more than two (2) successive 14 15 four (4) year terms. A director's term may be terminated by 16 the governor under the same procedure and in the same 17 manner as provided by W.S. 9-1-202(a) or a majority vote of the senate. Directors shall continue in office until their 18 19 successors are appointed and qualified. If a vacancy 20 occurs, the governor shall appoint a successor to serve in accordance with W.S. 28-12-101. The board of directors 21 shall select one (1) of its members to act as chairman of 22 23 the board of directors and one (1) member to act as

treasurer. The board of directors appoints the executive 1 2 director of the authority, who serves as the executive 3 secretary to the board and is the chief executive officer 4 of the authority. The executive director serves at the pleasure of the board. The executive director shall be an 5 ex officio member of the board but may not vote.
